

#### **CKC'S NEW IT SYSTEM AND ONLINE PORTAL WILL LAUNCH NOVEMBER 4TH**

An announcement from the Chair of the Board of Directors and the Executive Director of the Canadian Kennel Club

As the Chair of the Board of Directors and the Executive Director of the Canadian Kennel Club, it is our pleasure to inform you of an upcoming milestone in the IT4YOU Project.

From the start, the heart of the IT4YOU project has been about building relevant online tools that put CKC members in control, allowing you to take care of your CKC business, process online applications, track your dog's progress in Shows and Trials, and manage important information.

This project has not been without its challenges. We cannot express enough, our gratitude and commitment to our community during this time of key transition for our organization.

On behalf of the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) we are pleased to announce that the first stage of our new IT System will launch November 4th, 2019. This new online tool will redefine your member experience.

#### What to Expect at Launch

Starting November 4th, significant improvements and access to personalized information and key features will be available, including:

- · Online Membership Renewals;
- · A new, customizable Member Portal on CKC's website, full of personalized information such as:
  - · A Dashboard that will house a list of all dogs you own, a list of applications and their status', and a list of pending and completed orders;
  - Your Profile where all membership information and communication preferences will be stored and updated;
  - A listing linking to a summary page for each dog, including co-owned and transferred dogs, with all important dog information conveniently all in one place under the My Dogs link.
- · Online Studbooks ordering;
- · And an updated member benefits and resources section.

Additional features will be added throughout the weeks following the launch through a series of staged releases. The first release after launch will allow members to submit online litter applications and all types of dog registrations, in addition to Canadian Born Dogs.

As we enter into the final stages of testing over the next several weeks, we will share more information on how the new IT system will change CKC operations and improve your member experience. You can also keep up to date on the progress of the IT4YOU project through our website.

### UPDATE REGARDING REGISTERED DOG NAME LENGTH

On July 24, 2019, the CKC By-laws were approved by Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada to include an amendment to Section 28.10 Names, Subsections (c) and (d), which now reads as follows:

#### **28.10 NAMES**

The following rules shall apply with respect to the naming of dogs:

- (c) The registered name of a dog should be limited to thirty-five (35) characters, including spaces and punctuation. An additional fee will be incurred when more than thirty-five (35) characters are chosen to a maximum of fifty (50) characters;
- (d) The name of a Canadian born dog that is CKC registered may be changed by the owner(s) up to one (1) year from the date of registration. This change will only be permitted with the written consent of the owner at birth. No change in the registered name will be allowed after the dog has whelped or sired a CKC registered litter or progressed towards any CKC title.

This amendment allows owners at birth greater flexibility in naming their dogs now that they are not limited to only thirty (30) spaces. It also allows for greater flexibility to change a dog's name after the current restriction of sixty (60) days from the date of registration. Overall, this amendment will provide more lenience to owners in order for them to change the registered name of their dog.

Effective February 1, 2020, the CKC's Schedule of Fees will be amended to include an additional fee of \$10.00 for members and \$20.00 for non-members when registering a Canadian born dog with a name containing more than thirty-five (35) characters to a maximum of fifty (50) characters (including spaces and punctuation). In the case where a previously registered dog's

name is being amended to include additional characters, this fee will apply in addition to an amendment fee as set out in the CKC's Schedule of Fees.

Please be advised that up until January 31, 2020, the CKC will waive both of these fees.

## CKC PAYS TRIBUTE TO PAST CKC BOARD MEMBER ALAN BENNETT



Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) is saddened by the passing of past CKC Board Member, Alan "Al" Bennett, on Monday, October 7, 2019. Alan was dedicated to the Canadian Dog Fancy and wellrespected in the purebred dog community.

Al attended his first conformation dog

show in 1977 and never looked back. He started his judging career in 1993 and over the years, he judged in many countries including the United States, Mexico, Columbia, Argentina, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Spain, Lithuania, Germany and his home, Canada. Al was generous in dedicating his time to CKC and the purebred dog community. He served on the Board of Directors from 2000-2002 and 2004-2008, and was Chair of the 2008 Purina National. His volunteerism and contributions also extended to many committees and councils including Club Relations, Event Officiating, Working Certificate, Genetics and Medical, Herding Field Trial, Breed Specific Legislation Task Force, Responsible Dog Ownership, and Strategic Planning.

The CKC will be forever thankful for Alan's considerable contribution to CKC and the Canadian Dog Fancy. Our thoughts are with Alan's family and friends during this difficult time.
