

A GUIDE TO REGISTERING A CANADIAN-BORN DOG ONLINE WITH CKC

If you are registering a Canadian Born Dog on CKC's Online Portal, use this guide to ensure an easy and streamlined registration process.

Reading this guide carefully before starting the application will ensure you have all the necessary information and supporting documentation needed in order to successfully complete the online application.

To register a Canadian-Born Dog, you need to have obtained a Litter Registration Number with CKC.

QUICK HELPFUL TIPS:

- To complete your application, it is recommended to use Google Chrome as your default browser. If you are trying to complete an application using another browser, you may experience difficulties.
- When entering a CKC membership/contact number in an online application, ensure the number is entered **without preceding zeros**.
- When entering a Province/State into an online application, ensure the **full name of the province/state** is entered- abbreviations will not be accepted.
- If you submitted a Canadian-Born Dog Application online and encountered an error message, or the application has not appeared on the [My Applications page](#), it may be considered incomplete. **Incomplete Applications can be accessed on the [Dashboard page](#) under "My Applications"**. Click the **red "VIEW"** button to complete the application or the **red "DELETE"** button if you wish to restart and re-submit the application.

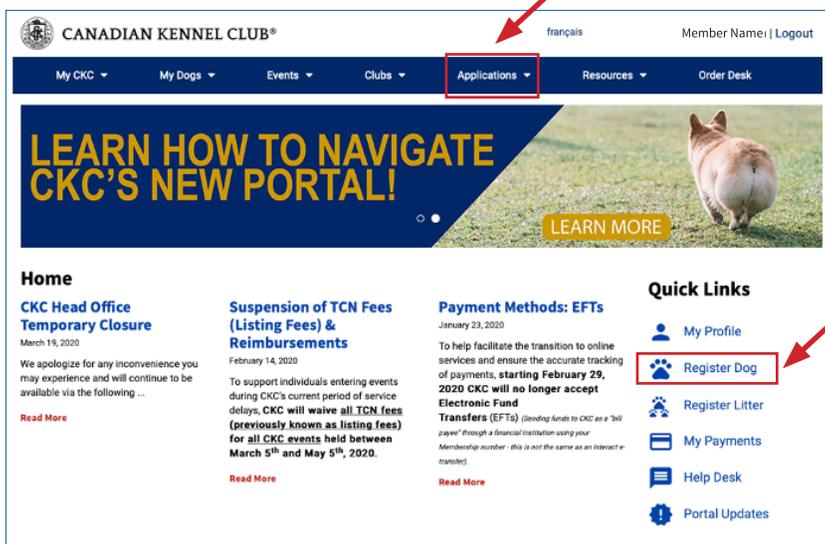

NON-BREEDING	<p>You must know:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • if you are transferring ownership of this dog on a non-breeding agreement. 	<p>If the dog will be on a non-breeding agreement, a Non-Breeding Agreement (signed by all parties) must be provided with the application.</p>

HOW TO REGISTER A CANADIAN-BORN DOG

1. Login to your Portal account. If you have not yet created your Portal account, visit [Creating a CKC Portal Account](#).
2. Once logged in, you will land on your Dashboard.



3. On the right hand side of your Dashboard, there is a section called **Quick Links**. Click on **“Register Dog”** under **Quick Links** to access the online application. ALL online applications can also be accessed by clicking the “Applications” tab at the top of the page in the blue header.

4. Ensure you read the instructions carefully before you start.

What you need to know before you start

Please read all instructions carefully prior to filling out the application.

In order to complete this application, the CKC Membership/Contact Number is required for all owners and related contacts. If a new owner is not a CKC member, and has never been a member in the past, a unique email address for this contact is required.

All individuals living within the same household will require a unique email address as any specific email address can only be associated with one (1) person's account.

All required supporting documentation can be uploaded to accompany your application once this form is completed and submitted.

UPLOADING YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

If you have answered questions in your application that indicate you require additional documents to accompany your application, an “**Upload Documents**” page will generate once your application has been submitted. Please ensure you upload all required supporting documents with your application.

1. Click the “+” next to Canadian Born Dog for an overview of the documents required to be submitted with your application, depending on the circumstances of the registration.

Upload Documents

Select the registration type below to determine documents that must be uploaded before submitting the application.

Canadian Born Dog

- o If the dog is spayed or neutered, a signed letter from a veterinarian.
- o If the date the dog was identified is not within the first year of age, the owner must provide a letter stating why the dog was not identified at an earlier date.
- o If the dog is being sold on a co-ownership with the seller(s) and the new owner(s), a completed Co-Ownership Form must be provided.
- o If the dog is being sold on a Non-Breeding Agreement, a completed Non-Breeding Agreement must be provided.

Registration of a dog born in the USA (breed not recognized by AKC)

Registration of a foreign born dog imported to Canada (can also compete in events)
