## CKC REMEMBERS FM BUTCH MACDONALD



The Canadian Kennel Club is saddened by the passing of Butch MacDonald, on
March 19, 2016.

Butch started his career in dogs in the mid '60s with German Shepherds and American Cockers. When he met the love of his life, Cec Ringstrom, they bred Doberman Pinschers and then Papillons under the Starstorm prefix. In 1992, after a long and successful professional-handling career, Butch started judging and became an all-breed judge in 2005. Judging provided him the opportunity to assess dogs worldwide, with assignments in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, China, Chile, Colombia, Hong Kong, South Africa, Sweden, Thailand and the U.S.

As a CKC member for 42 years, Butch gave back to the club, serving four years on the Discipline Committee and then as a Director of the Board for Alberta in 2000-2002.

Butch will be greatly missed by many. The CKC extends its sincere condolences to Butch's family and friends.

## SUMMER RESTRICTIONS FOR PET TRAVELLERS

Thinking of flying with your dog this summer? Be sure to check with your airline carrier as there may be pet travel restrictions due to high temperatures and heavy loads during peak summer travel periods.

WestJet accepts pets as checked baggage during the summer, with the exception of select locations from May 15 to October 31. WestJet Cargo planes are temperature controlled and can transport pets during the warmer months on domestic flights only. For more information, including details about shipping dogs, please call WestJet at 1-888-937-8538 or WestJet Cargo at 1-866-952-2746.

Air Canada is not able to transport pets as checked baggage from June 20 to September 10, 2016. However, Air Canada Cargo is specially equipped for the transportation of animals during the summer months and will accept pets during this period with the exception of select cities. Importantly, Air Canada Cargo does not accept warm-blooded animals for transport when the outside ground temperature is higher than $29.5^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(85^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$.

Just a reminder that Air Canada and Air Canada Cargo does not accept Brachycephalic breeds on any flights, due to an increased risk of heat stroke and breathing problems.

As always, we encourage CKC members to review countryspecific regulations re: restrictions on the entry of animals and vaccination and documentation requirements, prior to booking.
