

## **Air Canada Pet Travel Check List**

Travelling with your pet can be a lot of fun as long as you are well prepared and informed. Use the checklist below to ensure you have everything you need for a smooth trip with your cat or dog.

<b>Before you go</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Advise Air Canada or your travel agent that you are travelling with your pet so we can ensure that we have space and that there are no restrictions.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify documents, tags, licenses and vaccinations required for entry with the Embassy or Consulate General for each country on your itinerary.

<b>Kennel check</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Air Canada approved kennels (soft sided preferred if travelling in the cabin).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Familiarize your pet with the kennel well in advance of travel
<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirm your kennel is large enough to allow the animal to stand, turn around and lie down comfortably
<b>Departure day</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Allow additional 30 minutes over normal check-in times.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bring original copies of all required documents to present to the check-in agent
<input type="checkbox"/>	Feed your pet 4-6 hours prior to departure and provide water right until check-in time
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bring a leash for exercise prior to check-in and after arrival.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check weather for your origin, connection and departure cities.
