ALL OTHERS WHO ENTER THE GROUNDS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER PRIOR to ENTERING OR ENGAGING IN ANY ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUNDS. The waiver will be posted on the DOGSHOW.CA site as well as the club website. Please download prior to the event if possible.

### ENTRY FEES: \$60.00\* per dog per test

\* ENTERING ON DOGSHOW.CA WILL RECEIVE A \$3.00 DISCOUNT PER ENTRY.

**U.S. exhibitors**: Our bank will not accept cheques marked "payable in Canadian funds". Entry fees must be paid in Canadian Funds.

**LISTING FEE:** A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$10.50 per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records.

Entries should be submitted to the Field Test Secretary starting Monday June 24th, 2019 at 8:00 a.m.: Steve Short, Field Test Secretary 275164 Twp Rd 274 Rocky View, AB T4A 2W8 It is the exhibitor's responsibility to confirm that The Secretary has received their entries.

NOTE: In the case of electronic or telephone entries, the entry is not considered complete until fee is paid and a signed entry form is received by the Test Secretary.

All entry forms must be in the hands of the Field Test Secretary BY THE CLOSING DATE and entry fees paid in full. There will be no exceptions.

Once again we will have a PayPal service set up for this event so if you are entering late and your funds cannot be mailed please take advantage of this service. Please go to <u>www.gspalberta.com</u> for PayPal entries.

Entries close 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Draw will be held on Wednesday, July 10th, 2019 at 8:00 pm at the home of the test Secretary: (call Field Test Secretary for directions). Running order will be posted by no later than Friday July 12th. If you do not have an email address, please call the test secretary to obtain a schedule of running order.

All entries for the Field Test are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, and the land owners (SPRUCE CREEK UPLAND CLUB) and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

### **TEST INFORMATION:**

- Courses & Birds Partridge, Quail and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds
  released along the course. There will not be a bird field. Three birds will be released for the first dog tested and two
  birds per dog thereafter. In FDX 5 birds will be released for the first brace and two birds per dog after that. The GSPFCA
  reserves the right in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- Horses on the course Bird planters, marshals and judges may use horses. All other participants & spectators must be on foot. All dogs will be handled on foot
- All persons on the course in FD, FDA and FDX must wear a blaze orange garment. A hat alone will not be allowed. If you do not have one, one will be provided.
- Gallery: A gallery of spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. This will be at the sole discretion of the judges and handlers. Spectators in FD, FDA and FDX, must remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judges, marshal & gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately 8 hours of judging time.
- Starting times will be announced. (Earliest start will be 8 am.) Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- FDJ & FD dogs will have 20-30 minutes to complete all aspects of the test. FDA dogs will have 30-40 minutes. FDX dogs will have 30-45 minutes. Dogs will be run individually in the FDJ & FD Tests; FDA and FDX dogs will be run in braces.
- Firearms Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA & FDX, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by official gunners only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired please provide your own starting pistol.
- Bitches **in season** will be permitted to run. All bitches in season will be run at the end of the day on the respective course. Please notify the secretary or test chair if you have a bitch in season.
- **Collaring** a dog is allowed with the permission of the judge.
- Tracking collars: Tracking collars will be permitted. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. A dog that is located using a tracking collar during its heat is no longer under judgement.

- Training or exercising of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test.
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in the designated camping or headquarters area.
- Accommodation: No Camping will be allowed on the grounds. This is a one day event. Outhouse is provided.
- NO OPEN FIRES WILL BE ALLOWED, PERIOD
- Other accommodations available in the area: Olds, AB, Trochu, AB and Three Hills AB all have decent hotels and campgrounds. All are within 30 minutes of the grounds.
- **Food:** There will be a limited concession at the grounds. Lunches will be available for a nominal fee. Food may be prepaid with entry or purchased on site.
- Prizes Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test no ribbons will be mailed
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test Rules are available from the CKC. **NOTE: Make sure you review the rules for Field Dog Tests (available on the CKC website:** <u>www.ckc.ca</u>)
