- Dead ducks will be used in this trial.
- Males and females will be run in order of the draw.
- A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes.
- Wingers may be used in all stakes.
- Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.
- Eliminated dogs may be allowed to run out of contention in the minor stakes as time allows.

- Please note CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.
- Open & Amateur fees include the new \$5 NRCC running dog fee to support the National trials.
- Junior & Qualifying stakes may be combined. Therefore, dogs can only be entered in one minor stake.
