Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

EVENT REGISTRATION FEE

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

NEW – When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHX POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Section15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Cham- pion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. Entries positively close **6:00 p.m. Saturday, May 4, 2019** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The K-W Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. on Saturday, May 18, Sunday, May 19 and Monday, May 20, 2019. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your needs known to the club in advance. Please contact the Show Superintendent by the closing date of this show to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- 6. The building will be open from 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Access to the building will be available from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday night for setup.

Prizes:

Best in Sweepstakes - Rosette &/ or Prize 15% of entry fees.

Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes - Rosette &/ or Prize 10% of entry fees.

1st in each class 20 % of entry fee in class & Ribbon

2nd in each class 15 % of entry fee in class & Ribbon

3rd in each class 10 % of entry fee in class & Ribbon

4th in each class 5 % of entry fee in class & Ribbon 25% will be retained by club for administration

OFFICIAL CLASSES (ALL SPECIALTIES)

Junior Puppy – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 - 18 Months - a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner <u>and</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class - for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by Veterinarian procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Baby Puppy – a dog between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

Exhibition Only – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Brace: Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Team: Four dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Each entrant for Brace, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Parade of Champions, Titleholders or Veterans: Champion dogs must have completed all requirements for Championship status. Titleholders must have titles recognized by the CKC and AKC. Veteran dogs must be over seven years of age as of the date of the show. Spayed & neutered dogs or dogs in unorthodox trim may be entered.

Each entrant for these Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in Rally Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.


