Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** which Vizsla Canada Inc. reasonably determines, in its sole discretion, may be run during the hours of judging.

Start Time: 8:00 AM each day. All entrants will be provided with a running order and will be responsible for determining an appropriate time to arrive at the test site for their event. The first two entrants of the day will be notified by phone or email.

FEES: \$55.00 CDN for all categories Day of Entry Fees (see below) are \$60.00 per category A Listing Fee may be applicable (see below) All cheques are payable to: Vizsla Canada Inc. There will be no refunds once the tests are closed, either by date, or number of entries.

Draw Time: The draw for the running order will be held immediately after the close of entries, at the home of the Event Secretary. The Draw will be random and specific times cannot be assigned to any entrants.

Listing Fee: Dogs not registered with C.K.C. must pay a \$10.00 listing fee. A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number, Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) is not shown on the entry form.

Vizsla Canada Inc. reserves the right to remove a dog from the running order if entry fees have not been paid in full. Vizsla Canada Inc. reserves the right to refuse entries from persons who have failed to pay entry fees in full at prior tests. Fees for entries withdrawn after the closing time will not be refunded.

All entries for these Field Tests are accepted on condition that Viszla Canada Inc., its officials and members, and landowners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, these Tests. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

WAIVER: All attendees, volunteers and participants are required to sign a Release, Consent and Indemnity for Field Tests Waiver before being allowed to participate in or view the test (page 5).

Day of Test entries WILL be permitted, provided the entry limit has not been reached, and must be brought to the Event Secretary up to a minimum of thirty minutes prior to the start of the Test. Once the limit of dogs has been reached, no more will be accepted. **Please bring your dog's CKC registration information** with you to avoid a listing fee.

TEST INFORMATION:

Courses and Game: Quail and Chukar will be released. Other game birds may be present. The Tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There may be a bird field. Vizsla Canada Inc. reserves the right, in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.

Running: FD and FDJ dogs will be run individually. FDA, FDX and FDX/CH dogs will be run in braces or individually (where applicable, with a by-dog for backing). All handlers must carry a starter pistol.

- FDJ, FD, dogs will have 20-30 minutes, FDA, FDX, FDX/CH will have 30-40 minutes to complete all aspects of the test.
- FDJ may run two fields, depending on the entries and daylight.

Note that running times are an estimate only, and may be affected by absentees, dogs "picked up". It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.

All Handlers must carry a starter pistol.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season will be permitted to run in the second test at the end of each day. Bitches in Season will be kept confined away from any other dogs and away from test fields. Bitches in season will be watered prior to entering the field in a designated area and will be identified in the running order.

Training or exercising of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds before, during, or after the Test without the permission of the Event Secretary.

Collaring a dog will be allowed only at the Judge's instruction.

Tracking Collars that are legal for use in Canada and listed online at <u>www.akc.org/events/firel-trails/pointing-breeds/tracking-collars.cfm</u> will be permissible for use in CKC tests.

Gallery: At the handler's discretion, a gallery of up to 6 spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. Spectators must wear blaze orange, remain together at all times and follow the directions of judges, marshal & gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.

Test scores will be available from the Test Secretary after the completion of each test category. **NOTE:** If you have twice qualified your dog with any of our Judges, please notify the Test Secretary before the drawing time.

Moving up - eligible dogs may move up to the next level, provided they inform the Event Secretary one hour prior to the commencement of the test.

Prizes: Standard CKC qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test – no ribbons will be mailed.

SAFETY INFORMATION: Blaze orange - Blaze orange MUST be worn in the form of a hat and a vest during all test categories: FDX/CH, FDX, FDA, FD and FDJ. This includes gunners, handlers, judges, apprentice judges, volunteers and spectators. NO EXCEPTIONS!!! **FIREARMS** - Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA, and FDX shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by official gunners only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please provide your own starter pistol (not less than .22 calibre).

SPECIAL NOTE: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Complaints' Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Use of Live Game and Livestock:

The Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) supports and encourages the sport of dogs to hold various types of shows and trials. We encourage all dog owners to participate with their dogs in such activities as hunting and field trials, herding, tracking and competitive events intended to improve the overall understanding and quality of purebred dogs. It is indeed through the sport of dogs that reputable dog breeders continue to improve their individual breeds as well as the species itself, for all.

Clubs and those persons taking part in these activities must make every effort to ensure the safety of dogs, as well as live game and livestock, used in these activities. Any person non compliant in the safety of animals, including livestock and game, may be subject to charges of cruelty and those who have been convicted of cruelty to animals are ineligible for membership in the CKC.

All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Tests for Pointing Dogs' Rules are available from the CKC.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a nonmember of the CKC. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by the individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved to the next level.
