CHAPTER 20

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be

allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Included the dog awarded Winners.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the Dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best Breed of Best of Opposite Sex and then consult schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points Inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

IN NO CASE MAY A DOG EARN MORE THAN FIVE POINTS AT ANY SINGLE SHOW.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate the dog must

A: earn at least 10 Championship points under 3 different judges.

B: be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an ERN number.

C: have earned at least one 2 point win at either the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

DOG SHOW RULES, CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which has been assigned and "individually C.K.C.
