What is the difference between a CKC membership number and a CKC Contact number?

The answer is simple – a paid membership fee!


While a CKC membership has many benefits and contributes to the larger voice of the purebred dog community, CKC membership is not required for certain club executive roles. CKC Club Policy states that the President and Vice-President, together with one of the Secretary and/or Treasurer must be CKC members in good standing and residents of Canada.

If the club has members entering executive roles that do not wish to become CKC members and it is not required for their role, they are still required to be in good standing with CKC, and have an active and updated CKC contact number to be entered on the club's record. Here's how:


Go to the CKC public website at www.ckc.ca and click the red 'Log In' button in the top right corner:
