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MESSAGE from the Board

INTERIM SOLUTIONS AND DEALING WITH CHANGE

To maintain the receipt of postal subsidies from Heritage Canada and Canada Post Corporation under the Publications Assistance Program (PAP), the CKC successfully restructured our Membership categories to accommodate the necessary requirements two years ago. On April 22, 2009, notice was received that Heritage Canada had placed new restrictions upon the publication industry which would place significant impact on the CKC magazines. As of the month of August 2009, the *Official Section* can no longer be carried as a separate “ride along” publication in *Dogs in Canada* magazine mailings.

Since receiving this news, we have reviewed various options and surveyed the membership. We continue to seek the most viable alternative to this challenging situation. The CKC needs to communicate and we want to do it in the most responsible manner, taking into consideration financial implications and member expectations.

The distribution of CKC Board minutes and details of the business we conduct has been available for decades in the form of “hard copy” reporting. For the short term however, as we work through significant cost implications and consider viable options, the *Official Section* will only be published on-line, beginning with the September issue. We hope that this will be acceptable to most members as we seek a longer term solution to this sudden circumstance. If it is not possible to access the *Official Section* information through the CKC’s electronic communication network, it will be reproduced **free of charge** and mailed to those requesting a hard copy. We encourage some patience as your input on this situation is tabulated and while all possibilities are considered, weighed and examined before coming to you with a recommended plan for the future.

The August issue, in the exact format as the printed version, is posted to our website and easily accessed directly from the home page. The *Official Section* on-line has been available for Members since 2006 and will continue to be posted each and every month providing the same information but in a more timely manner since the requirement for a two month publishing lead time is obviated.

If you have not done so, remember to register your email with CKC in order to receive your *Official Section* “direct-to-you” via monthly email.

As we have faced change so many times in the past, we will, with the support of our Members, once again find workable solutions to the challenge at hand.

We thank you for your support and please...check the website, read the monthly Bulletin and watch for news, surveys, and updates.

CONFORMATION JUDGES

Please note that in accordance with Section 6.3.5 of the Conformation Show Rules, clubs and judges must adhere to the Judging Schedule. Entries cannot be moved to another time slot.

“Where a time is shown for the judging of a breed or group, the said breed or group shall not be judged prior to the stated time. Where the group judging is to follow the judging of the breeds in that group, the show-giving club must allow sufficient time before the start of the next class.”

Moving a single or small entry of any breed will alter the Judging Schedule.

CONFORMATION JUDGES – New Permit Numbers

Effective January 1, 2010, any judge that is issued a new permit will be required to judge the following number of dogs in order to complete the permit requirements:

Group 1	Full Group = 145	Half Group = 72
Group 2	Full Group = 80	Half Group = 40
Group 3	Full Group = 139	Half Group = 69
Group 4	Full Group = 67	Half Group = 33
Group 5	Full Group = 114	Half Group = 57
Group 6	Full Group = 84	Half Group = 42
Group 7	Full Group = 104	Half Group = 52

ALL CLUBS HOLDING SPANIEL FIELD TRIALS

In accordance with Section 11.2.1, Requirements, of the Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations:

“To acquire an All-Age Field Trial Championship, a dog must:

- Win at least 10 points including at least one 5-point win
- The 10 points earned must be earned under at least 2 different sets of judges
- A dog must have placed no less than 4th in an Amateur or Open All Age Stake in which live full winged gamebirds (such as Pheasant and/or Chukar Partridge) were used.”

To ensure that Head Office issues the appropriate championship certificates for dogs that have met the requirements, clubs must indicate on the Event Date Application if live full winged gamebirds will be used as well as the type of gamebird. This information will then be marked in the event for future reference. This information can be placed in the box at the bottom of the Type of Event section marked Other.

This information must also be published in the Premium List for all Spaniel Field Trials events.

CANINE GOOD NEIGHBOUR TESTS

Please be advised that all clubs/organizations wishing to hold a CKC Canine Good Neighbour Test must submit an Application To Hold A Canine Good Neighbour Test to Head Office for approval. Applications should be submitted a minimum of 90 days prior to the date of the test. Applications received within 90 days from the date of the test will not appear in the CKC's Calendar of Events.

Please be aware, results that are submitted by clubs/organizations that have not obtained approval from Head Office prior to the test by submitting an application to hold a Canine Good Neighbour Test, will not be accepted and certificates will not be issued.

DOUG WINDSOR CKC DIRECTOR ZONE 6, ONTARIO WEST



Doug Windsor, CKC Director for Ontario West (Zone 6) is a CKC Life Member and All-Breed Judge with international experience. Now retired from a teaching career focused on Math and Science, he has a wealth of academic credentials including a Masters degree in Science from the University of Guelph and a Bachelor's degree in Education from the University of Toronto. Doug's interests in education carry into the world of purebred dogs as he mentors new participants through his intense involvement within the dog community. Mr. Windsor was the Retriever Working Certificate Representative in Zone 6 for 12 years prior to his election to the CKC Board and has been active for 34 years as a Board Member and Life Member of the K/W Kennel Club, holding all Executive positions including Show Chairman.

Currently, Mr. Windsor is on the Board of Directors for the K/W Kennel Club and is the President of the Elora Gorge Kennel Club and the Southwestern Ontario Sporting Dog Club. He is a founding member of the Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada (1974) and has been a Director of the Cambridge and District Humane Society for the last 12 years.

Doug and his wife Wendy keep busy training conformation classes on a weekly basis for the K/W Kennel Club. Doug is also a member of the Dangerous Dog Bylaw Appeal Committee for the City of Cambridge — a position he has held since the Committee's inception five years ago.

Doug has been breeding and showing Golden Retrievers, Flat-coated Retrievers and Belgian Sheepdogs under the Butterblac name for 36 years. His kennel's success has included 50 American Champions and over 100 Canadian Champions, including six different BIS winners and numerous Obedience and Agility Champions.

Doug has been the breeder of Canada's #1 Flat-coated Retriever 13 times since 1980. Mr. Windsor is keenly interested in breeder and judge's education and is looking forward to contributing at the national CKC level as a Board Member throughout his term in office.

DELETE

10. Cropped Ears

- (a) Although the Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club affirms the principle that the breeders control the standard of their breed and that this control is exercised through the breed clubs wherever possible, the Board of Directors wishes to encourage the exhibition of dogs with natural ears and thus recommends to the breeders and the breed clubs of breeds traditionally shown with cropped ears to revise their breed standards so as to include two (2) statements:
 - (1) A statement to the effect that when two (2) exhibits of similar merit compete, the exhibit with cropped ears shall not be given preference solely by virtue of being ear cropped.
 - (2) A clear description of the desired natural ear."

MOTION # 11-12-08

MOVED BY Mr. Bernier: "THAT, Chapter XII, Legislative Policy Statements, Policy Statement – Cropping and Docking from the Policy and Procedures Manual be amended as follows:

Although much of the history of the reasons for cropping the ears and docking the tails of dogs remain unclear, the Canadian Kennel Club affirms that cropped ears and docked tails are a significant part of the history of many of the breeds of purebred dogs. Moreover, breeders continue these practices for historical or hygienic ~~and aesthetic~~ reasons.

Although the Canadian Kennel Club wishes to be attentive to changing societal values with respect to purebred dogs, the Canadian Kennel Club must also represent the wishes of its members. For the majority of the breeders whose breeds have been traditionally cropped and/or docked, their sense of the history of their breed and their ~~aesthetic~~ appreciation of their breed necessitates these practices. However, just as the breeders of purebred dogs have modified the temperament of the historical "fighting breeds" so that they reflect the values of modern society, so breeders are modifying their practices with respect to ear cropping. In recent years in the conformation and performance events sanctioned by the Canadian Kennel Club the number of uncropped dogs has increased significantly and their presence and form is appreciated by the majority of members of the Canadian Kennel Club.

The Canadian Kennel Club has historically operated on the principle that the breeders and the breed clubs determine the standards for the breeds and therefore will not unilaterally legislate changes to these breed standards.

The Canadian Kennel Club is concerned that ear cropping and tail docking be done under the most humane circumstances and to this end, has adopted the policy of barring for life from all Canadian Kennel Club events, any person or persons who performs or causes to be performed, the ear-cropping of any dog without the use of a general anesthetic.

The Canadian Kennel Club does not believe that any ban on cropped and/or docked dogs in the events of Canadian Kennel Club will stop the cropping and docking of dogs in Canada because these services will still be readily available in the United States and there will remain those who wish ~~this cosmetic surgery~~ **these procedures** for their dogs whether purebred or not, whether participating in the events of the CKC or not.

The Canadian Kennel Club considers tail docking and dew claw removal, practices which are distinct from ear cropping. Tail docking and removal of dew claws is necessary for safety in field working breeds and for hygienic reasons in other breeds. Moreover, tail docking and removal of dew claws, when performed on young puppies, is consistent with similar practices in the livestock industry."

Mr. Bernier reported that in accordance with Motion #40-09-08, the Legislation Committee had reviewed Chapter VI, Shows & Trials, Section U, Performance Event Number Policy with a view to allowing the listed breeds to participate in this program with the result that the Committee did not consider a change to this policy advisable. The Committee recommended that Subsection 3 (a) (4) be modified to remove the reference to the Miscellaneous Class List.

Breeding purebred dogs is a professional activity which requires knowledge and a commitment to a well planned breeding program in order to uphold the integrity of the breed and meet established breed standards.

Spaying and neutering are simple, safe surgical procedures that ~~have no adverse effect on the health and temperament of the dog~~ **may provide health and temperament benefits**. Consult your veterinarian for advice and avoid accidental and unwanted breeding. Animal shelters are full of unwanted companion animals that were not bred within a planned breeding program."

Judging Cropped and Docked Breeds (reference agenda item 9.1)

Where the standard is unspecific as to the cropped and/or docked state of the exhibit then the judge must exercise his own discretion in the matter. It is noted that in practice, some judges do penalize or withhold with regard to breeds for which the standards list cropping and/or docking as a fault or a disqualification."
