# MESSAGE

## from the Board

### THE YEAR IN REVIEW

As some things change, many remain the same and others still necessarily inch forward. 2009 was a year that demonstrated this to perfection. The new Board and CKC staff responded rapidly to elements that changed outside our control but impacted dogs in Canada. We methodically pursued controversial issues that are moving forward as we find the correct paths and we faced items shaking the status quo for the purebred dog world.

In recent weeks, the number of communiqués from the FCI have increased. It would appear we are now on their regular distribution list and are considered a partner in dogs internationally. Our presence at FCI events over the past several years has shown tangible results and the level of communication between FCI and CKC is better than it has ever been. Fires continue to burn on the issue of Cropping and Docking, sparked by the New Brunswick Veterinary Medical Association's decision to ban these procedures effective 2009. We have opened a formal discussion at the national CVMA level on this and other issues common to both organizations.

On the ever-present BSL front, the valiant efforts by the Banned Aid Coalition to fight the breed ban in Ontario (Bill 132, implemented August 29, 2005) met with disappointment as the Supreme Court refused the appeal. The economy continues to plague everyone involved in the Fancy and at CKC, the loss of grant subsidies for the mailing of the Official Section fostered rapid changes to respond to the federal government's changing criteria. The above issues and others as well forced change to our world, but resilient and flexible as ever, our membership has coped!

Responsible Dog Ownership Week (RDOG Week), for example, showed a doubling of our successes from our inaugural year (2008) and continues to be a strong, relevant and fun contribution to dogs in our society. The CKC Foundation is growing and the Purina National - a CKC Charity Event, once again made significant financial contributions.

Working with Air Canada, we were very pleased to have been once again instrumental in bringing pets back into the cabin of many flights, facilitating the safe transportation of dogs across our large and challenging country. Working with the Quebec government and building on our resolve to forge strong partnerships with like-minded organizations, as a result of our Director's interest and co-operation on a multi-organizational Task Force, we are seeing activity in this Province to improve the regulation of commercial dog breeding facilities in Quebec.

Shows and Trials have remained reasonably constant in the face of this economic downturn, proving once again that the dog fancy is a committed and stable environment, able to pursue its' goals in the face of challenging times.

As we do every year, the Board of Directors, thank you, the membership of the Canadian Kennel Club, for remaining steadfast in your resolve for a better place for our dogs, for continuing as a strong and dedicated membership body and for continuing to look not only at the past but into the future with determination and resolve in support of dogs in Canada!

Our thanks for 2009 and best wishes for 2010!

Late submission or failure to include unused forms will result in no discount being applied. This discount is only made available to Canadian Resident Regular Members for registration of Canadian-born litters of two puppies or more. It does not apply to any associated transfer fees.
