PROFILING YOUR DIRECTORS: BRIAN TAYLOR

BRIAN TAYLOR CKC DIRECTOR, CENTRAL ONTARIO



Brian Taylor, Director Zone 7 - Ontario Central, moved to Canada in 1956 and currently resides in Burlington Ontario. Since coming from England, Brian has spent most of his time living in various Southern Ontario communities as well as Halifax. In 1963, he imported a German Shepherd from England and has owned and or professionally shown many breeds including Golden Retrievers, Irish Setters, Beagles and Rottweilers. His career as a professional handler began in the late '60's and continued until he retired from handling in 1984. Along with his handling Brian managed a career of some 45 years in the elevator business and worked in all facets from mechanic to President and although now retired from that business, still provides services as a consultant from time to time. When breeding dogs with Judith Taylor, their combined efforts produced some top winning Goldens, but Brian candidly notes and credits Judith as the mastermind and commented that it happened, "with just a little input from me."

In recalling his handling days and showing so many top dogs, it was hard for Brian to identify a "best moment" but he fondly recalls taking BIS at Credit Valley with 1,000 plus entries. Sometimes, he still gets the urge to be back in the ring and will go to an Irish specialty with his daughter Jill and help her out. Brian decided to start judging in 1983 due to business commitments which were becoming more demanding and therefore not leaving enough time to properly devote to the dogs in his care.

Over the years, Brian notes that many individuals contributed to his knowledge and skills including Joan Gill, Daphne Philpott, Betty Crawford, Eve Whitmore, Shirley deBoer, and was quick to add that there were many more along the way.

As advice for the novice in the dog world, Brian was of the strong opinion that everyone's first task would be to get a good mentor or two and "listen, listen, listen and then ask, ask, ask..." After a few years, you can then speak and offer a much better and more informed opinion.

Brian is keen on education, both in formal ways and informally and sees a number of opportunities to increase the value of CKC Shows and Sanction Matches for the benefit of our membership. With his experience as a handler, breeder, judge and businessman Brian will undoubtedly be bringing these and other discussions to the Board over his term as a new Director.
