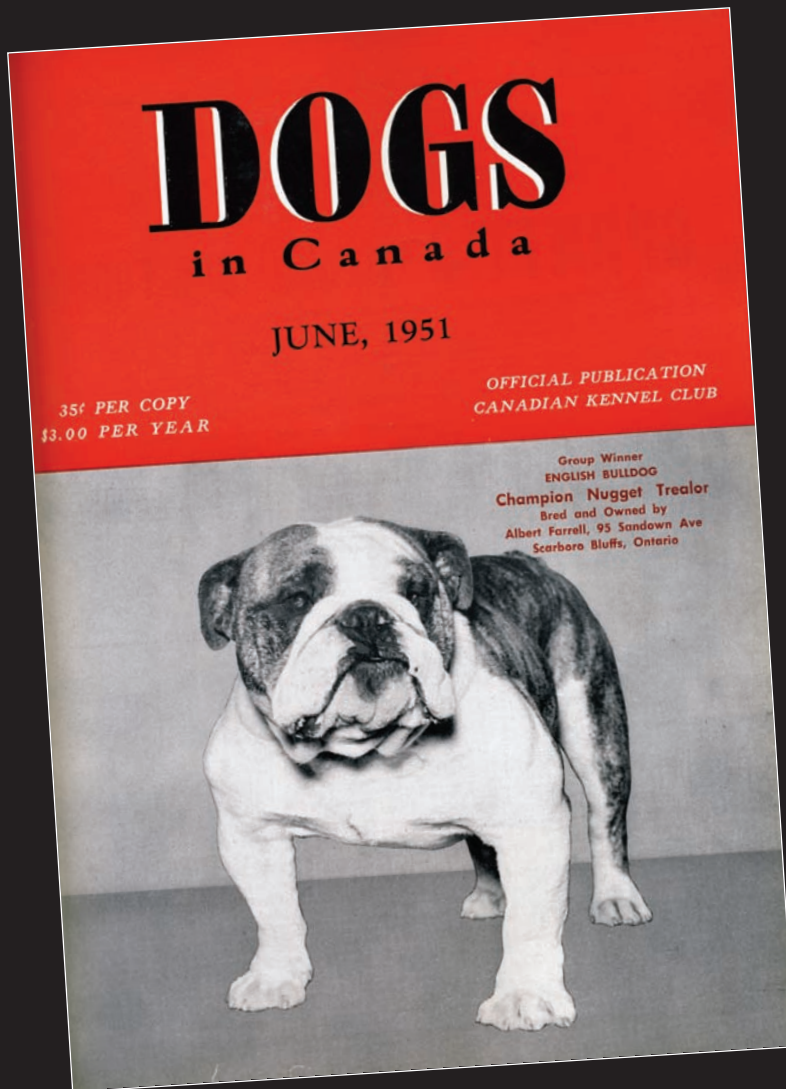

## FINANCIAL RECOVERY UPDATES

As you are, no doubt, well aware, the Canadian Kennel Club is faced with a significant financial challenge. Dropping registration numbers, a slight decline in entries and falling membership, all products of a worldwide recession, have combined in the last quarter of 2009 to leave the CKC in a deficit position.

Since early April we have sent out a variety of communiques to Club Executives and individual members regarding the situation and how we expect to move forward. We've now posted these communications and our Auditors Reports for the past four years under the title *Financial Updates*, on the CKC website.

## KENNEL AND BENCH NOW AVAILABLE EXCLUSIVELY ONLINE

In our efforts to contain costs during our Recovery initiative, we have decided to publish Kennel and Bench in an electronic format only, available through the CKC website. Unfortunately, given our current financial predicament, the cost of printing and inserting each issue into Dogs in Canada could not be justified. This change in policy begins with our June issue, and will continue until further notice. We apologize for any dissatisfaction this may cause.

## CKC REGISTRATION AMNESTY

The Canadian Kennel Club is offering the opportunity for breeders, who may have, at some time in the past, registered a litter but failed to register the individual dogs to do so before May 31, 2010 and we will waive the late fees.

This is the first time in our history that we have made this type of offer, and it has the potential to wipe out years of late fees. Breeders who have sold dogs without registration would be well-advised to take advantage of this offer at this time.

The CKC Amnesty Program for registration of Canadian born dogs is available from April 15 to May 31, 2010 and applies to both online and mail-in registrations.

## MEMBER VOICE

During one of our Member Voice surveys, Harrison of Harbour Grace, Newfoundland indicated that he would like CKC to call members when there is a problem with paperwork.

We are pleased to inform Harrison and our members that the Registration Division attempts to call when there is a problem with paperwork and the issue can be easily rectified. There are some instances when the problem is more complex and the data operator is unable to contact the member with a simple resolution. Some instances include: missing signatures, affidavits that are not notarized, incomplete non-breeding agreements and missing foreign documents.

### CKC MEMBER PROCESSING DISCOUNT

If all dogs from a Canadian-born litter are registered at one time, they may receive discounts of 5% to 10%, depending upon when and how they submit the applications to Head Office. (Please see Registration fees at left). In order to qualify for the discounts, all unused computerized Individual Registration forms associated with the litter, including those for dogs that are deceased, must be returned to Head Office along with corresponding completed applications. Late submission or failure to include unused forms will result in no discount being applied. This discount is only made available to Canadian Resident Regular Members for registration of Canadian-born litters of two puppies or more. It does not apply to any associated transfer fees.

### MEMBER RATES

### METHOD OF PAYMENT

#### Regular Members

Current Regular CKC Members in good standing may pay by credit card when they login to our website at [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca). Regular Members also have the option to make a payment via their personal financial institution, through web, telephone or in person. Payment may also be submitted by mail. Acceptable forms of payment are personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Post-dated cheques are not acceptable.

#### Non-Members and Associate Members

Non-members, Associate Members and minors must forward payment with work submitted. Payment must be made in the form of certified cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Personal or business cheques from non-members will not be accepted unless they are certified. Any non-member work received with a non-certified cheque attached will be rejected.

#### Non-Residents of Canada

Non-residents of Canada must make payment in Canadian dollars. Due to the constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques or money orders in foreign currency will not be accepted. U.S. cheques and money orders will be accepted at par.

#### Declined Cheques/Declined Credit Cards

A service charge of \$30.00 will be levied on all cheques and credit cards declined by the bank and no further work will be performed for the individual until such time as all outstanding amounts and service charges have been paid in full.
