

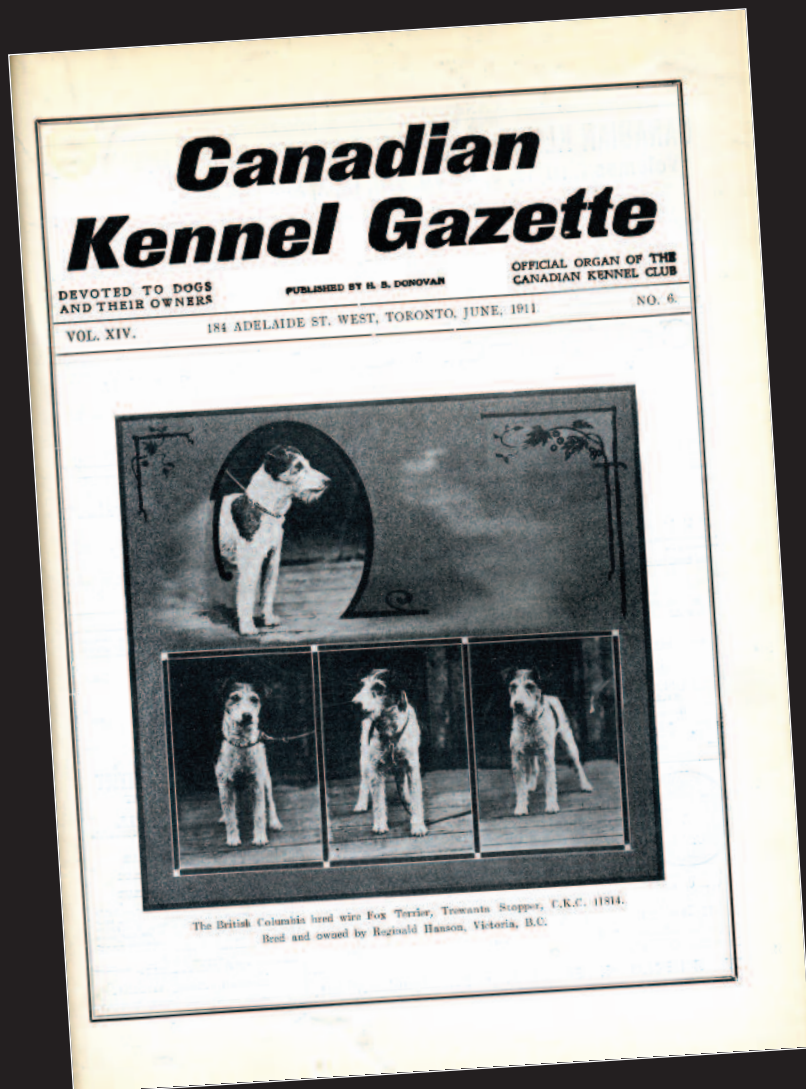

Mr. Stanley Gordon Whitmore

An individual well known, respected and loved by many people passed away on Friday March 18, 2011. His accomplishments, contributions and associations within the dog fancy are many and valued by not only those who knew him personally but many as the unknown recipient of his life's work breeding, with clubs and CKC activities. Stan was a Judge, CKC Life Member (63 consecutive years) and joined the Canadian Kennel Club on January 1, 1949.

Mr. Whitmore was born in New York, Ontario, in 1919 and grew up with dogs in the family. He came by his love honestly through his father who bred Wire Fox Terriers and Irish Terriers under the kennel name of "Westminster". After serving overseas with the 17th Field Artillery in World War II, he returned and married his wife Eve Whitmore in 1948 to share a passion for purebreds throughout their marriage. Stan and Eve bred Boxers, Bassets, Pointers, Greyhounds and Dobermans and Stan became an All Breed Judge in 1958. At that time, at the age of 39, Stan was the youngest person to have obtained All Breed status. Not one who was much for travelling, Stan focused his efforts here at home and the U.S., declining many international invitations - but did make the exception accepting assignments in Australia and New Zealand.

As a life member of Scarborough Kennel Club he held various executive positions over the years including President and was also a member of the Boxer Club of Canada, American Boxer Club and Progressive Kennel Club.

It was no surprise that on retiring from the Ontario Government in 1984, his time was filled with his dogs, as well as the breeding/showing of fancy pigeons and bantam's, the keeping of canaries and parrots. Not content to just look at his birds, Stan had recently built breeding boxes and an incubator to try and breed his budgies. In the last three years, Stan took up oil painting and model plane making, completing his last model just a few weeks prior to his death...remarkable for a man of 92 years young! A true "man of many talents" - Stan will be missed greatly by many members of the dog fancy and beyond.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

At the regular March 2011 Board Meeting, a description of the roles and responsibilities of the Board of Directors was approved for publication, prior to the election of a new Board.

This role description can also be accessed at any time via our member website, under Membership Services, in the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual, Chapter IX, Board of Directors.

Position Title: Board Member

Time Commitment: Variable from a few hours a week to several hours per week.

Term: Three years. Elected as per Section 12 of the By-laws.

Accountability

The Board of Directors is collectively accountable to Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) members in all zones in Canada. They are accountable for CKC's performance in relation to its Mission and Strategic Objectives and for the effective stewardship of financial and human resources.

Authority

Individual Board members have no authority to approve actions by the CKC, to direct staff, or to speak on behalf of the association unless given such authority by the Board.

Qualifications

- CKC Regular Member in good standing.
- Resident in the relevant electoral zone.
- Have completed one (1) year continuous membership in CKC.
- Commitment of time.
- Openness to learning.
- Computer literacy.

Personal Characteristics to Consider

- Ability to listen, analyze, think clearly, work well with people individually and in a group.
- Possess knowledge and skills in more than one area of Board governance: policy, finance, programmes and/or personnel.
- Willing to prepare for and attend Board and committee meetings, ask questions, take responsibility and follow through on any given assignment, and evaluate one-self.
- Develop certain skills to recruit CKC members, read and understand financial statements, ability to learn more about the CKC as an organization.
- Possess: honesty, sensitivity to and tolerance of differing views, friendly responsive approach, zone-building skills, personal integrity, and a sense of humour.

Responsibilities

- Attend all Board and committee meetings and special functions as approved.
- Work as a team member and support Board decisions.
- Be informed about the organization's Mission, By-laws, services, policies and programmes.
- Review agenda and supporting materials prior to Board and committee meetings.
- Make a serious commitment to actively participate on committees, task forces and offer to take on special assignments.
- Volunteer for and willingly accept assignments and complete them thoroughly and on time for CKC and its members.
- Abide by the By-laws, code of conduct and other policies that apply to the Board.
- Establish, review and monitor policies that guide core operational practices (e.g. financial management, human resource management).
- Keep up to date on developments affecting CKC and its members.
- Attend and participate in the Annual General Meeting.
- Assist the Board in carrying out its fiduciary responsibilities.
- Keep informed about issues relevant to the mission and objectives of the CKC.
- Be responsive to CKC zone members.
- Educate CKC members about the role of CKC.
