MEMBER VOICE REPORTS

Since the inception of our CKC MemberVoice Program in October 2006 we have received numerous comments and suggestions directly from our membership. Some are unique ideas, others common themes to everyone. We have received input on large scale initiatives and simple recommendations, all of which are reviewed and considered as possible opportunities to improve our service to all.

During mid-year of 2010, we noticed a reccurring comment from members concerning call wait times. This prompted us to examine further. We found that the call wait times were at their lowest in the months of January to April averaging at 2 minutes and 15 seconds. The increase in wait times doubled to 4 minutes and 54 second in the months of May to September. (Please note that French calls are generally a minute to two longer in the queue as there are 2 staff that are bilingual.)

After reviewing the data carefully, we began to understand that the reason for the dramatic increase was a direct result of staffing; the Client Services team was reduced by 2 leaving a total of 5 staff to answer inbound calls. At the time of the increase, the club was faced with financial challenges and was obligated to make reductions and cut costs and this, unfortunately, affected our Client Services team.

We thank the members for connecting through MemberVoice. It was the members' input that allowed the CKC to delve deeper into a service-related issue and promptly adjust to meet the needs of our members. As a result, we improved by almost 50% with an average wait time of 2 minutes and 34 seconds during the months of October, November and December.

Non-Members and Associate Members
