

CKC BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING



SYNOPSIS OF THE MARCH 10, 14 AND 15, 2011 BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

The following is a brief synopsis of the key items of business that were addressed at the March 10, 14 and 15, 2011 Board meeting held in Etobicoke, Ontario Please note that rules and policy changes shown below are paraphrased for the sake of brevity. In the event of dispute, the specific wording of such changes should be taken from the official minutes of the Board meeting. The detailed minutes of the meeting will be formally approved at the next regular meeting of the Board.

- The resignation of Mr. Joe Mauro as Chief Executive Officer of the Canadian Kennel Club and President of Apex was accepted.
- Mrs. Leila Bahorie was appointed interim Chief Executive Officer of the Canadian Kennel Club and interim President of Apex Publishing.
- A "request for proposals" will be developed and a Selection Committee was established to fill the vacancy occurring as a result of Mr. Mauro's resignation. Members of the Selection Committee are Lee Steeves, Line Champagne, Ed Graveley, Bob Rowbotham and Margaret Jones.
- Minutes of the December 11 & 12, 2010 Board meeting were adopted.
- 5. The following correspondence was received as information:
 - Letter from Dr, Donald L. Reynolds, Dean, Atlantic Veterinary College, University of PEI thanking CKC for the Ongoing Support of the Canadian Kennel Club Award
 - Letter from Linda Watson, President, Vizsla Society of Ontario Protesting the Non-Member Tracking Fee
 - Letter from Susan Van Hees, Quail Ridge Cocker Spaniels re: request that CKC withdraw any form of donation to Canadian Veterinary Colleges until CVMA ceases further discussion of anti-docking/cropping regulations
 - Letter from Carol Hartnett and response to same from Bob Rowbotham re: Non-member participation fee
 - Letter from Michael O'Brien re: Cost of breeding, training and administering champion dogs
 - Letter from Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada re: Support of CKC ear Cropping Policy
 - Letter from Susie Miller, Director General, Food Value Chain Bureau, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada re: Membership Reinstatement

- 7. CKC financial reports for the fourth quarter were received.
- 8. CKC 2010 audited financial statements were accepted.
- 9. CKC 2011 capital budget was approved.
- Apex financial reports for the fourth quarter were received as information.
- Apex 2010 audited financial statements were received as information.
- 12. Amendments were made to the Policy & Procedures Manual effective immediately as follows:
 - a. Chapter VII, Judges, Section B Applicant
 Conformation Judges, Sub-Section B, C, (1) Licensing
 Maintenance for All-Breed, Groups & Breed Judges.
 The amendment was made to include the CKC
 Advance Judges Seminar as acceptable education for
 judges
 - b. Chapter VII, Judges, Section B –Applicant
 Conformation Judges, Sub-Section 5, g-Applicant
 Conformation Judges (Initial Permit). The change is
 the first step in the process in an effort to make judge
 observations more efficient and meaningful
 - A new section 6 was added to Chapter VII, Judges, Section K – Emeritus Judge. The additional new policy is Section 6: Requirements for Emeritus Conformation Judges

- Chapter XII, Legislative Policy Statement. The housekeeping change was made to replace the Cropping and Docking policy with the Tail Docking and Dew Claw Removal policy approved at the September 2010 meeting and the Ear Cropping policy approved at the December 2010 meeting
- Chapter VI, Shows and Trials, Approval of Judges, Section R. 1 was deleted. The change was housekeeping since a CKC Book of Judges is no longer produced
- 13. Amendments were made to the Policy & Procedures Manual effective January 1, 2012 as follows:
 - Chapter VI, Shows and Trials, Section 5 J (e) was deleted. The change removes the requirement to include a complete exhibitors list at the back of the Show Catalogue, or the owner's address within the confines of the dog entry information.
 - Chapter VI, Shows and Trials, Section 5 (i). The change deletes the requirement to include a space to record "Group" and "Best in Show" awards in the Show Catalogue and replaces it as an option of the
 - Chapter VI, Shows and Trials, Section J (m) was amended to remove the requirement to include a copy of the Judging Schedule in the Show Catalogue and replaces it with as an option of the Show giving Club
- 14. The following appointments were made:
 - Margaret Robertson was appointed 2011 Honourary Chair
 - Dr. Alastair Cribb, Dean, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Calgary was appointed 2011 Honourary Veterinarian
 - Michael Catton, Anthony Dibley, Robert Lindey, Laurie Savoie & Gail Forsythe were appointed to the Appeal Committee
 - d. Doug Windsor was appointed Chair of Hunt Test Council
 - Margaret Jones was appointed to serve on the CKCF Board

- 15. The mandate of the Show Modelling Committee was extended for events held prior to March 31, 2012.
- 16. A Master Breeder Program and an International Master Breeder Program were approved.
- 17. A description of the roles and responsibilities of the Board of Directors was approved for publication prior to the Election of a new Board.
- 18. An Ad Hoc Committee was established to examine priority dates.
- 19. A motion was adopted to send the Chair of the Board and the Interim CEO to the World Dog Show in July.

CKC MEMBER PROCESSING DISCOUNT

If all dogs from a Canadian-born litter are registered at one time, they may receive discounts of 5% to 10%, depending upon when and how they submit the applications to Head Office. (*Please see Registration fees at left*). In order to qualify for the discounts, all unused computerized Individual Registration forms associated with the litter, including those for dogs that are deceased, must be returned to Head Office along with corresponding completed applications. Late submission or failure to include unused forms will result in no discount being applied. This discount is only made available to Canadian Resident Regular Members for registration of Canadian-born litters of two puppies or more. It does not apply to any associated transfer fees.

MEMBER RATES

Member rates and discounts are applied if the applicant is currently a Regular Member of The Canadian Kennel Club. Membership privileges are not transferable. In the case of co-owners, member rates apply only if all of the co-owners are Regular Members of the CKC in good standing; otherwise, non-member rates and rules apply.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Basic and Premier Members

Current CKC Members in good standing have the option to make a payment on-line by credit card when they login to our website at www.ckc.ca. Members may also send payment by mail when submitting work for processing or charge it to their Member Credit Account. Payment can be made in the form of personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Post-dated cheques are not acceptable.

Non-Members and Associate Members

Non-members, Associate Members and minors must forward payment with work submitted. Payment must be made in the form of certified cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. Personal or business cheques from non-members will not be accepted unless they are certified. Any non-member work received with a non-certified cheque attached will be rejected.

Non-Residents of Canada

Non-residents of Canada must make payment in Canadian dollars. Due to the constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques or money orders in foreign currency will not be accepted. U.S. cheques and money orders will be accepted at par.

Declined Cheques/Declined Credit Cards

A service charge of \$30.00 will be levied on all cheques and credit cards declined by the bank and no further work will be performed for the individual until such time as all outstanding amounts and service charges have been paid in full. Additionally, memberships, Member Credit Account privileges and use of all Club privileges may be temporarily or permanently suspended.
