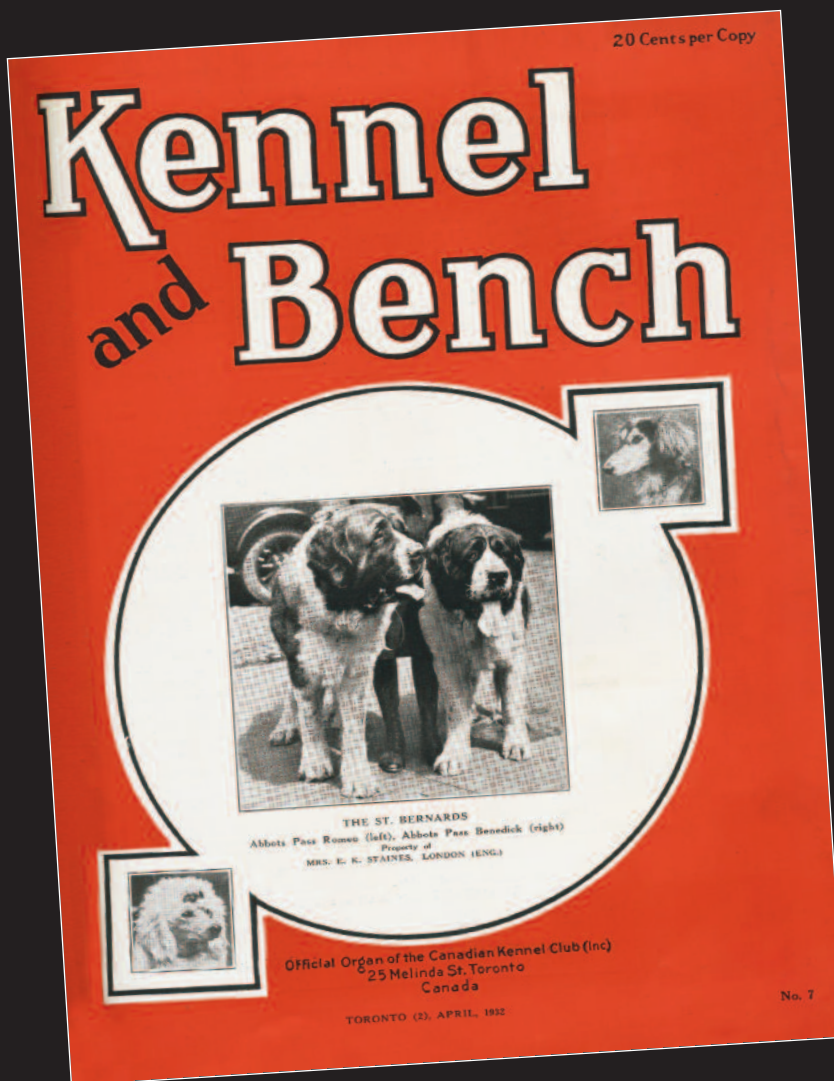

2012 SUMMER RESTRICTIONS FOR PET TRAVELLERS

If you plan on flying with your dog this summer, please note that, due to potentially high temperatures on the ground at some airports, Air Canada and Air Canada Express flights operated by Jazz are not able to transport pets as checked baggage from **June 20 to September 10, 2012**.

However, Air Canada Cargo is specially equipped for the transportation of animals during the summer months and will accept pets during this period with the exception of select cities. Importantly, at any time when the temperature is over 29.5 °C, Air Canada Cargo may not be able to accommodate animals. For further assistance, please call 1 (866) 615-1155 or contact your local Air Canada Cargo office.

WestJet accepts pets as checked baggage during the summer, with the exception of select locations from May 1 to October 1. WestJet Cargo planes are temperature controlled and can transport pets during the warmer months on domestic flights only. For more information, please call WestJet at 1 (800) 581-9499 or WestJet Cargo at 1 (866) 952-2746 (1-866-WJCARGO).

As a reminder, we encourage all CKC members to review the requirements for shipping dogs within Canada and to the U.S. in advance of any shipment.

CKC RECOGNIZES RETIRED DIRECTOR JAMES MALCOLM CAMPBELL



It was with immense gratitude that the Canadian Kennel Club, at the December 2011 Board of Directors' meeting, presented CKC Director, James Malcolm Campbell, with a Judge Emeritus license, in honour of his dedicated service to the CKC and to the dog world in general.

NOTICE BOARD

James Campbell was a CKC Director of Zone 12, British Columbia, Interior and Yukon for three terms, from 2005 to 2011. During this time, Mr. Campbell was also the Chair of the Breed Standards Committee and Chair of the Retriever Field Trial Committee.

James' varied career took him from jockeying, to the Navy—to Canada Customs (from 1964-1976)—during which time, he began working with licensed handlers on weekends. In 1971, the AKC licensed Mr. Campbell as an All Breed Handler and he travelled to Alaska, California, New York, South America, Bermuda, Hawaii and Europe—showing client's dogs. In 1990, Mr. Campbell's family started Western Dog Shows Ltd., Secretarial Services and his daughter Kim has been the owner since 2006.

The CKC truly appreciates Mr. Campbell's commitment to the Club and to the dog fancy at large and wishes him a very relaxing retirement.

Margaret E Robertson, Honorary Chair of the Canadian Kennel Club for 2011, of Cochrane Alberta, formerly of Victoria B.C. passed away in Rimbey, Alberta on Tuesday, March 27 at the age of 88. Margaret lived a full life, devoted to her family and to her love of purebred dogs. Margaret was a Life Member of the CKC with 57 consecutive years of service and in 2008 retired as an All-Breed Conformation Judge after travelling extensively throughout Canada and the U.S. Her judging career took her to almost all continents and many, many countries around the world including New Zealand, Australia, Argentina, Taiwan and Thailand (at the age of 82).

Margaret was involved in dogs for all of her 88 years, and loved to tell people that as soon as she could walk, her mother shoved a string in her hand and had her show her mother's Boston Terriers. In addition to breeding, showing and judging, Margaret was always there and willingly to share her expertise, experience, and advice on breeding, to help with whelping litters, or anything else she could contribute to someone with "dog related" needs; breed did not matter—she loved them all.

Margaret bred and showed Basenjjs very successfully and her "Merlea" bloodlines are still sought after and regarded highly. Her dogs did extremely well in both obedience and conformation and in particular, her "Dainty Dancer" went BIS 8 times and in 1958 was awarded the CKC Medal for "Best Canadian Bred in Shows Award" for that year. As a Life Member of the Basenji Club of Canada and Basenji Club of America, Margaret loved to give seminars and through them, provided encouragement and guidance to upcoming judges on how to judge the breed.

"I think one of the hardest things she ever had to do was to retire from judging," said her daughter Linda Hewitt. "Even the day before she passed away, we were planning on attending the Red Deer Dog Shows so she could see all her dog show friends, sit at ringside and watch the dogs she loved so much."
