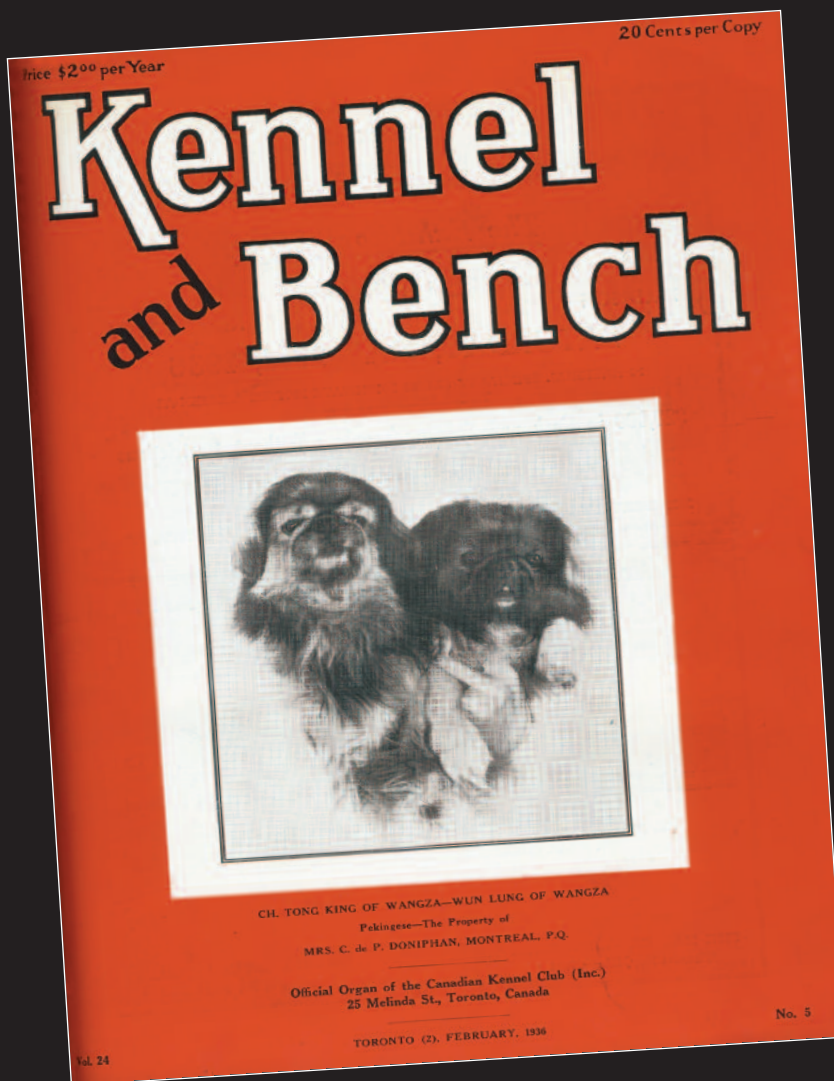

CHANGES TO POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL FOR 2013

Revisions have been made to the Policy and Procedures Manual, which became effective January 1, 2013, as a result of motions passed by the Board of Directors.

5 YEAR EDUCATION PORTFOLIO FOR CONFORMATION JUDGES

At the December 2012 meeting of the Board of Directors, the following amendment was made to policy regarding the 5 Year Education Portfolio for Conformation Judges.

Judges

8. Licensing Maintenance for All-Breed, Groups and Breed Judges

- c) Licensed judges are encouraged and expected to engage in a self-directed program of professional development. Recognizing that a judge has a commitment to on-going education, all judges will maintain an educational portfolio with appropriate documentation and/or certification. This portfolio will be reviewed and approved by The Canadian Kennel Club at the end of each five (5) year cycle.

ADD NEW

- (i) Should a judge fail to meet these requirements, the judge's license will be held in abeyance until such time that the requirement is met."

To comply with this new requirement, there will be a six month grace period which expires on June 30th, 2013. This means that all Conformation Judges that were licensed, or on permit, in 2008 or earlier, must submit a 5 Year Education Portfolio to the Shows and Trials Division at CKC Head Office no later than June 30th 2013.

Judges that were issued their initial judging permit after 2008, will be required to submit a 5 Year Education Portfolio within 5 years of the year in which the initial permit was issued.

CKC MASTER BREEDER AND INTERNATIONAL MASTER BREEDER PROGRAMS

In January the Canadian Kennel Club launched an exciting new program that offers special distinction for our member breeders who have consistently produced quality animals and who work hard to promote the value of purebred dogs. Called CKC Master Breeder and International Master Breeder, the awards require that the applicant attain a comprehensive list of achievements in order to receive these prestigious designations.

There is a one-time fee of \$250 for the Master Breeder award and \$300 for International Master Breeder.
