NEW EXCUSALS AND DISQUALIFICATIONS FORM FOR CONFORMATION SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS

In an effort to streamline the process for recording and communicating excusals and disqualifications to the affected exhibitors, Shows and Trials has developed a new form that is to be completed by the event secretary.

The Excusals and Disqualifications Form should be filled out and submitted along with the event results. This will allow notification to be forwarded to the affected exhibitors when the results are received, rather than waiting until they have finished processing them.

Please note this additional step does not replace the current procedure wherein a judge records the excusal or disqualification information in the judge's book.

BOARD APPROVES FEE CHANGES FOR SHOWS & TRIALS

During the March Board of Directors meeting some fee changes were passed and will take effect on May 1, 2013. All changes fall under the category description OTHER FEES, Titles and Certificates.

- Adding Shutzhund Titles to CKC Records:
Was 16.10. Now 20.00
- Recording/Issuance of Versatility Titles:
Was 16.10. Now 20.00
- Application for Reinstatement of a Disqualified Dog:
Was 53.90. Now 107.80 (members); 161.60 (non-members)

UPDATE ON THE CKC POODLE STANDARD

The Canadian Kennel Club has been receiving correspondence regarding the Poodle Standard and consideration by the Poodle Club of Canada for possible changes to that standard. At this time it can be confirmed that no amendments to the standard have been approved or made. Any amendments proposed by the Poodle Club of Canada will need to follow the established procedure as laid out in CKC Policy RGOO2.

As required by the process, we understand that the Poodle Club of Canada may be coordinating a vote within its membership on the proposed changes. If the vote results meet the requirements of CKC policy the standard will be reviewed by the Breed Standards committee and, if supported, then published for comment for CKC members representing poodle owners, prior to any approvals.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR DISCIPLINARY REPORT
