## WINTER AIR TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS FOR PETS

Due to chilly temperatures and increased passenger and cargo loads expected over the holiday season, winter restrictions are in effect for the transportation of pets travelling by air.

Please note that WestJet holiday embargo dates apply to pets travelling as checked baggage. Therefore, WestJet is unable to accept animals as checked baggage from December 15, 2017 to January 6, 2018. From December 11 to December 14, 2017, and from January 7 to January 10, 2018 a maximum of two animals will be accepted as checked baggage. Also note that WestJet Cargo is unable to transport pets from December 15, 2017 to January 6, 2018.

Air Canada is unable to transport pets within North America as checked baggage or via Air Canada Cargo from December 15, 2017 to January 12, 2018. This restriction applies to flights within North America, or on international flights with a connection in North America during this time.

## NEW PERMIT NUMBERS FOR CONFORMATION JUDGES

Effective January 1, 2018, any judge that is issued a new conformation judging permit will be required to judge the following number of dogs, as well as meet other requirements in policy (Policy & Procedures Manual, Chapter VII, Section B, 5), in order to complete the permit requirements:

### January 1, 2018

Group 1 – Full = 114 – Half = 57  
 Group 2 – Full = 62 – Half = 31  
 Group 3 – Full = 92 – Half = 46  
 Group 4 – Full = 50 – Half = 25  
 Group 5 – Full = 76 – Half = 38  
 Group 6 – Full = 60 – Half = 30  
 Group 7 – Full = 81 – Half = 40

# APPEAL COMMITTEE REPORT

The following is a report of the decisions reached by the Appeal Committee at its meeting held on September 25 and 26, 2017.

**Appellant:** Don Constable, Aurora, ON (Non-Member)  
**Respondent:** Rhonda Bailey, Calgary, AB (CKC Member)

**Discipline Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the complaint alleging Rhonda Bailey approached a judge directly or indirectly to favour an entry.

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the appeal and upheld the decision of the Discipline Committee.

**Appellant:** Tami Butterwick, Brownfield, AB (CKC Member)  
**Respondent:** Andrew Seaward, Edmonton, AB (CKC Member)

**Discipline Committee's Findings:**

Reprimanded Tami Butterwick for failing to abide by the Code of Ethics for CKC Members, the Code of Ethics for Judges and acting or performing in a manner which may be deemed as contrary to the basic principles and Objects of the Club and/or in the best interests of the Club. Furthermore, the Committee levied costs of the investigation and hearing in the amount of \$250.00.

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the appeal and upheld the decision of the Discipline Committee.

**Appellant:** Renate Crews, Tottenham, ON (CKC Member)  
**Respondents:** Marjorie Blackman, Calgary, AB (CKC Member),  
Cindy Stec, Cannington, ON (CKC Member)

**Registration Committee's Findings:**

Denied a request from Renate Crews to authorize registration of a litter without the signatures of Marjorie Blackman and Cindy Stec.

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the appeal and upheld the decision of the Registration Committee.

**Appellant:** BC All Breed Pointer Club, Sidney, BC (CKC Recognized Club)

**Respondent:** Tom Doherty, Didsbury, AB (CKC Member)

**Discipline Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the complaint alleging Tom Doherty subjected judges and members of an event committee to abuse and harassment.

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Allowed the appeal but concluded that there was no finding of unsportsmanlike conduct. The Committee further directed that the appeal fee be refunded to the appellant.

**Appellant:** Élise Houle, Saint-Christophe d'Arthabaska, QC (Non-Member)

**Respondent:** CKC

**Registration Committee's Findings:**

Directed that Elise Houle provide breeding records from January 1, 2012, to December 31, 2016, in accordance with the Club's By-laws, Section 22.3, and the Policy and Procedures Manual, Chapter IV, Registration, Section M. (1).

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the appeal and upheld the decision of the Registration Committee.

**Appellant:** Zbigniew Zarzecki, Mono, ON (CKC Member)

**Respondent:** CKC

**Executive Director's Findings:**

Directed that Zbigniew Zarzecki be suspended of the privileges of the Club for a period 90 days for failing to provide a new owner with a duly transferred certificate of registration within six months of the date of sale. Furthermore, administrative costs for the investigation were levied in the amount of \$169.50.

**Appeal Committee's Findings:**

Dismissed the appeal and upheld the decision of the Executive Director.
