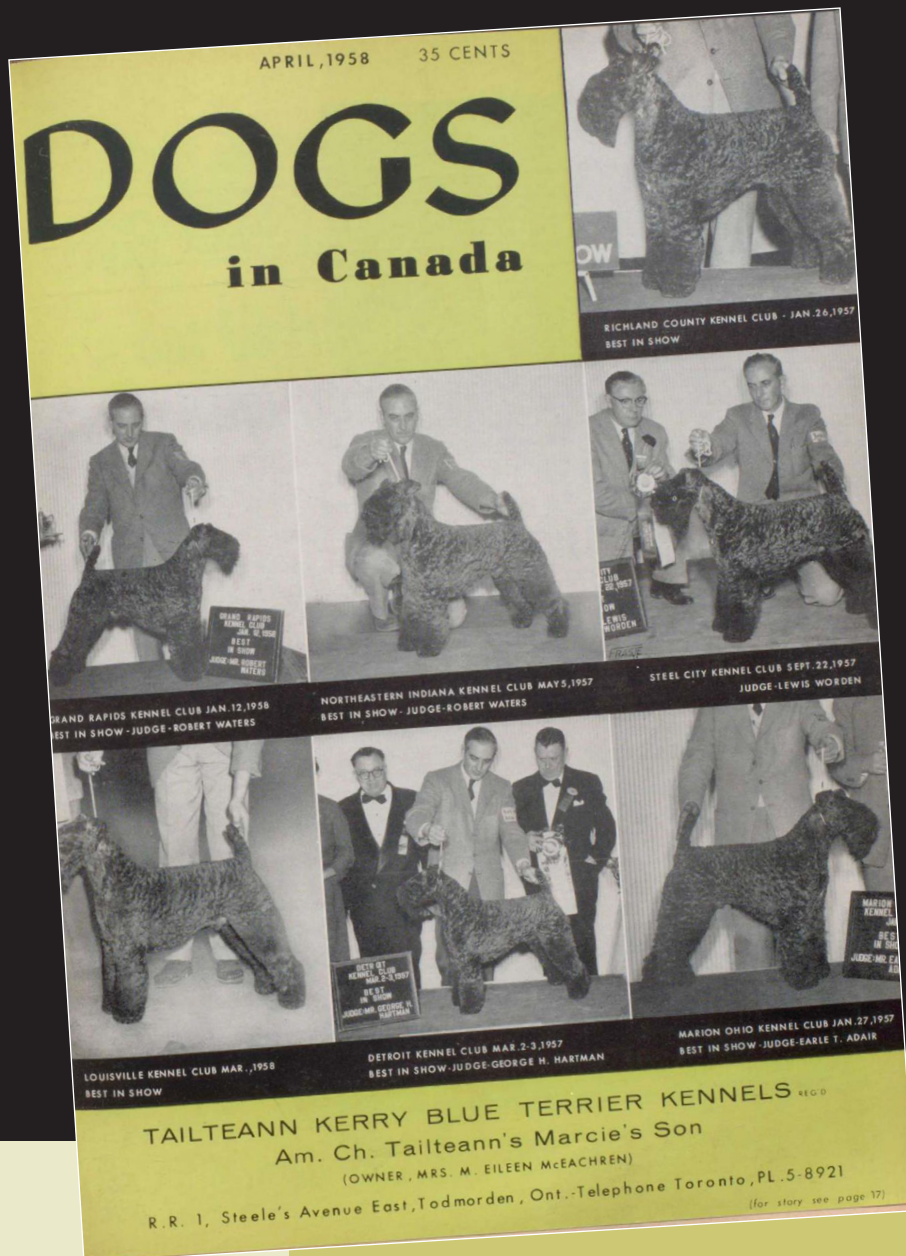

A CKC Registration Number, a Performance Event Number, a CCN Number, a Miscellaneous Certification Number or an Event Registration Number, along with providing CKC the fee of \$20 plus applicable tax and completion of the CKC North America Diving Dog Title Application Form located on our website under Forms>Exhibitor Forms.

be used by breeders at home for pregnancy confirmation, early detection of uterine abnormalities that require urgent veterinary

assistance and determining all puppies have been delivered at the end of whelping.

Long-time CKC member, Loreta Serafini of OZ Yorkshire Terriers, had this to say about her experience in the class:

*"I wasn't sure that an ultrasound machine could make my job any easier when I signed up for the course, but knowledge is*



*knowledge. When I scanned the two girls I brought with me, I realized that this was going to help me in a big way. I can confirm pregnancy, confirm multiple puppies (so important to know in a toy breed), accurately predict or confirm birth dates and this one really blew my mind—accurately reveal a fetus that had died in*

*utero. Thank you to Pet Tech Solutions for bringing this option forward—I never would have done it on my own."*
