

A CKC Registration Number, a Performance Event Number, a CCN Number, a Miscellaneous Certification Number or an Event Registration Number, along with providing CKC the fee of \$20 plus applicable tax and completion of the CKC North America Diving Dog Title Application Form located on our website under Forms>Exhibitor Forms.

be used by breeders at home for pregnancy confirmation, early detection of uterine abnormalities that require urgent veterinary assistance and determining all puppies have been delivered at the end of whelping.
