## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

- **1.** Attention U.S. Exhibitors: A Personal cheque will be accepted, however, it must be payable in US funds and for the full entry amount. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Do not mark cheque "payable in Canadian" or "funds at par". Your co-operation is appreciated.
- **2.** If entering the same dog in conformation, obedience or exhibition only please use a separate entry form for each class.
- **3.** An **INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED**. Please ensure that your postal code is included. ALL NSF CHEQUES WILL BE CHARGED A \$20.00 SERVICE CHARGE.
- **4**. Exhibitors must abide by the errors made when making the entry, regardless how or who made the entry.
- **5**. An entry will not be accepted unless accompanied by the required fees.
- **6**. The Cobequid Dog Club reserves the right to reject any entry subject to CKC rules.
- **7**. Only dogs, which are eligible for registration or are registered by the CKC, may be entered in these Show & Trials.
- **8.** Overpayment of entry fees up to a maximum of \$5.00 will be considered a donation to CDC Trophy Fund.
- 9. The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC.

## 10. There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue.

- 11. Conformation Show Move Up Chapter 13, Sec. 13, of the Dog Show Rules:
- "A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and has completed the requirements of championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of these rules, after closing date and time for entries of the show, but whose championship is unconfirmed by CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the request for transfer is submitted by owner or handler to the Show Secretary, **IN WRITING**, at least one hour prior to the opening of the show."
- **12.** Obedience Trial Move Up A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, **IN WRITING** by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.

# **OFFICIAL JUNIOR HANDLING**

There will be Junior Handling **CONFORMATION** Saturday and Sunday. Registration will be in the Show Secretary's room in the morning, and must be done at least one hour in advance of the scheduled judging. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or in Exhibition Only. Junior Handlers MUST in 2016 have a Jr. Number from CKC to have wins tracked. This is a free service.

A fee of \$2.00 for Junior Handling is required at time of registration.

#### CLASSIFICATION

#### CONFORMATION CLASSES:

Baby Puppy-for dogs 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show (does not compete for points)

Junior Puppy-for dogs 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy-for dogs between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 Month-for dogs between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show Canadian Bred-for dogs which was born in Canada

Bred by Exhibitor-for dogs owned and handled by the breeder

Open Class-for dogs 6 months of age or older

Specials Only-for dogs who are Canadian Champions

Exhibition Only-for dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing

that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 1 puppy.

## **OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate)

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

## **RALLY CLASSES:**

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Team Rally ring size is 40' by 60'.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C

A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate.

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC

events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN number simply does the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to The Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, Card holders name and signature. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. #### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**THE PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW WILL BE THE SHOW BUILDING AND ENTRANCE. The show premises will be** Opening at 7:00 am each day **and on** Friday March 24 from 4:00-8:00pm (sharp) for early set up. The Show/Trial Judging **will** start at 9:00am unless entries warrant an earlier start. Judging schedule and identification will be mailed as soon as possible after the entry closing date. Identification of an accepted entry for dogs must be presented at the entrance to the show premises, and only dogs entered in the shows and trials will be permitted to enter the venue. The Cobequid Dog Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an

exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog in the ring when required. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the shows and trials. Only dogs entered in the show are permitted within the show precincts please. Electrical outlets will not be available to exhibitors. Due to issues beyond our control we will be using a much smaller venue for conformation but we are promised heat. For this reason EX PENS will not be permitted. Thank you for your patience. Rule 12.2.2 Puppies 3-6 Months

- a) Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes.
- b) Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes including parades nor are they required to be listed in the catalogue.

# One puppy per exhibitor will be permitted at this show.

## **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

The Schedule to be employed in the determination of points allocated a dog awarded a dog awarded "winners' shall be as follows:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at any All Breed Championship Show will be credited with Five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.
