Toronto Sheep Dog Trials.

By the Jndge, Mr. Bjorkeland.

Taking into consideration the difficult conditions we have to contend with, we must admit that the trials were, if not entirely successful, at least very good.

In order that no advantage may be given to one dog more than another, the sheep used for these trials are bought from the cattle market, and unfortun ately, are mostly sheep that are not used

to dogs.

When we consider the limited space for work, it is certainly most trying to a dog's temper and coolness. This was clearly illustrated in our first day's trials, when ever faithful "Bob" broke his trio and had hard work around the hills of "Port Arthur" before he got them gathered again, and took the full time limit of 15 minutes to pen.

It will not be fair to criticize the work of any of the dogs here, as I have no doubt they are excellent workers in the field and pastures. I only want to impress the necessity of working close to sheep and slow, as one single quick movement or sharp bark may send the sheep

on a stampede.

The second day was a failure. There was a black sheep in the bunch, and when sheep commence jumping a fourfoot picket fence long before the dogs are in sight, the prospects are but poor for a good exhibition. An exhibition we certainly had at the east end of the grand stand, where our genial friend, Dr. Bell, tried to stop the before mentioned black sheep. The force of the contact was too great for the doctor's equilibrium, and as there were six more of the same stamp coming, and as sheep have a peculiar way of following their leader blindly, taking their jumps from exactly the same spot as the first one, it follows that Dr. Bell had a rather uncomfortable position.

The sheep were lost on the "Midway" and I was sorry to hear that Dr. Bell

declined a seat at dinner.

On the third day "Bob" won the championship. Of the thousands of spectators that watched this performance from the grand stand I heard only the

highest praise, and I will add that this dog kept his temper better than any dog I have ever seen, aithough he was greatly provoked all along the line by a very stubborn sheep. If he was worked a little more by hand motion, and less with words of command, he would be very near perfection. "Bob" lays claim to high breeding, and has the natural gentleness of the pure-bred Collie.

To prospective contestants, I would like to say, that next year it is the intention to have the trials where there will be more room for wide working; but notwithstanding this, I repeat, "Train the dogs for close work; work quietly and keep cool, and do not under any consideration allow the dog to

handle sheep roughly."

In conclusion, I beg to tender my thanks to all whom I came in contact with for their courtesy and general good-fellowship. To Dr. Bell and Mr. John G. Kent especially.

The world's greatest annual exhibition, Toronto, will ever live in my memory as one of the most pleasant events.

Toronto Dog Show beats all Records in Entry and Attendance.

The Toronto Dog Show has passed into history as being the most successful show ever held in Canada. And this not alone in entries-and they were far in the lead-but also in attendance and in the interest taken in the animals benched. It meant hard work and lots of it, especially on the part of Dr. A. W. Bell, the Superintendent, and Mr. John G. Kent, Chairman of the Dog Show Committee, who were tireless in their efforts to advance the interests of Canada's big show. The other members of the committee were assisted by volunteers, who deserve the thanks of the Association and of owners both.

As in the past, there was a great deficiency, both in quantity of and quality in the attendants supplied, and too much time was consumed in getting the dogs into the rings. Mr. McGaughey, who acted as "stage manager," was helpful here, and under adverse circumstances, as he was far from well.

Mr. Mortimer had a lot of work to do -almost too much-caused in great part by Mr. Harding Cox's failure to keep his engagement, a great disappointment to those who had entered especially to get his opinion. Mr. Mortimer had three solid days of hard work.

Mr. Parker Thomas coolly handled the immense entry in Sporting Spaniels. He will tell us what he thought of them.

Mr. Sweetnam had not a large entry in Bloodhounds, but a distinct advance on former years. His report will be found elsewhere in this issue.

Mr. Fraser, who took Mr. Cox's place in these breeds, had a light entry in English Foxhounds, but a very decent lot of Airedales.

Mr. Hungerford pulled a big entry in Collies, but all or nearly all were out of coat, as was to be expected at this season.

Mr. Clair Foster had something to do in the big lot of Bull Terriers that came before him.

Dr. Ford took the Bulldogs in the absence of Mr. Earle.

Mr. Marsh Byers did not satisfy the Setter men, and many of his awards were questioned. In the English variety he had a mixed lot to pass on.

Mr. C. A. Stone filled the breach in the absence of the Pointer judge, and satisfied himself.

Several judges' reports must hold over for next issue. Fine weather and full coffers made the committee happy.

DISEASE OF THE DOG'S TEETH.

Continued from last month.

The most serious disease of the dog's teeth is inflammation of the covering of the fang of the tooth, together with that of the tooth-socket or alveolus, which brings about receding of the gum and loosening of the tooth, the root of which is bathed in pus, particles of food, and saliva. The gums are spongy, bleed on the least touch, and the mouth gives off a repulsive odor. It may or may not be associated with tartar. It frequently arises after distemper, typhus, or other debilitating disease. It may be arrested for a time in young dogs, but usually the teeth fall out or have to be extracted. As this disease is a progressive one, and mostly occurs in dogs that have their food cut up finely or have soft puppy food given them and teeth are not essential, should any of them become loosened they should be extracted. If the gum has receded in young dogs after some debilitating disease, it should be brushed with peroxide of hydrogen to see if it will arrest its progress. Prevention should be aimed at by giving augs tearing food.

The rarest disease of the dog's teeth is true dental disease, caries, or properly called decayed teeth. As not one in twenty, or more, thousand dogs suffer from it, it need not be discussed, beyond mentioning should it arise, the teeth should either be stopped or extracted.

An associated disease of the carnassial, sometimes precarnassial or cutting molar or back tooth of the upper jaw is an abscess or swelling on the cheek just below and a little in front of the eye, which bursts and gives rise to a discharge and then heals up, to break out again and again, forming a fistula, etc. it is mostly due to some disease of the tooth or teeth, which should be extracted, as no other treatment is of permanent use. It is also seen in cats.

There are several defects in the position of the teeth in the jaws, and also defects of the jaw itself, so that the teeth do not meet properly; and as these are not diseases, but only faulty or arrested developments, they will not be discussed, but only mentioned here. The commonest defect is undershot, where the lower jaw protrudes in advance of the upper jaw. All degrees of deformity are encountered, that of the upper jaw sometimes advancing several inches. In some cases of cholera, affecting the head and jaws after distemper during youth, when the bones of the skull are still yielding to pressure, the teeth protrude from the mouth outwards at right angles, so that the inner surface of the lower ones, and not touching at the points.—The Stock-Keeper.

THE KOMONDOR (Hungarian Sheepd g.)

The great number of the Komondors at the last Vienna show, and the many things which are being now written about this dog, which is quite unknown in this country, induce me to give an accurate description of this magnificent animal. The Komondor measures from 23 inches to 31 inches at shoulder. His color is pure white, sometimes with a little yellow on the ears, if we do not count the quite grey specimens. The head resembles that of the wolf, the forehead is large and a little rounded, the expression is very intelligent, the eyes black, and so are the evelids, the nose, and the lips. The nose is preferred when pure black, but, as it is the case with all white dogs, the above color is seldom met with; the nose is mostly dark-brown The muzzle is rather long. or grey. The ears must be small, high-set, and are being carried "projecting at the sides of the head," when the animal is quiet; when the latter is agitated, the ears are carried in a similar manner as those of Borzois. The neck is of average length and very strong. The shoulders sloping, the elbows well under. Loose shoulders, very long ears, and thick head are faulty. The coat must be dense, hard, and undulating. The tail must be very hairy, as well as the hind legs, especially in the middle. The tail is carried high when the animal is agitated; but the "carriage sideways" is faulty. nails on the toes ought to be black; but this rule is not enforced. The Komondor possesses the following properties: He is a magnificient guard, very courageous and faithful. Notwithstanding his temperament, he agrees well with other dogs, and does not bite persons. The Komondors are being used in their native land (Hungary) as guards for

small and large cattle, not only for sheen. They are much bigger than the English Sheepdogs, as they have very often to fight wolves, which are a very frequent occurrence in Hungary nowadays. The breeding of Komondors is not yet pursued in a sporting manner, and belongs now solely to half-wild shepherds, and, as it is said in Hungary, they must be satisfied with what they have. The first step to improvement was the last show in Vienna. As Hungary is very dry in summer the color must be got against the dust, and not against the dirt, therefore it is the pure white color which is being preferred. The coat ought to be rather smooth than curly; but in that respect the Komondors are not thoroughly-bred enough. There are often found smooth and curly-coated dogs in the same litter.
