NOTES AND COMMENTS

An Airedale for the West : Mr. R. G. Sterling, Red Deer, Alta., has imported a valuable Airedale bitch, in whelp to Clonmel Chorister, from Mr. Holland Buckley, the owner and breeder of many champions. This bitch was especially mated by Mr. Buckley to produce winners for Canada.

Now on a Farm : Mr. T. A. Barr, Brantford, Ont., has secured a sixty acre farm at Mohawk, four miles from the city, which will be chiefly devoted to his dogs and visiting matrons. Arrangements have been made with Mr. Barr's brother in Brantford, to receive all bitches shipped to this kennel so that no unnecessary delay will occur and they will receive the best of attention.

Obos : Mr. R. Tyrwhitt has bred the Billy Obo bitch, Lily Obo, formerly Resnob Lillian, to Mr. Lance Farewell's Count Obo, and is expecting some winners about the middle of July.

Mr. Wade Dead : It was with a good deal of regret that we heard of the death of an old friend, Mr. Wm. Wade, Oakmount, Pa. Mr. Wade was a member of the Canadian Kennel Club for many years and took an active interest in its welfare. A many sided man and a philanthropist he was a great admirer of the English Mastiff of which breed he had more than one good one. Later he became enthused with the old English Sheep Dog. He was greatly interested in the education of the blind and took a somewhat active part in the development of the world famous

Helen Keller. It was a pleasure to us on several occasions to be able to assist him in some small degree in his work for the uplift of those whose misfortune debars them from seeing as we see. A man of upright character and the most strict integrity he was unalterably opposed to anything that savoured of sham or meanness.

The late Mr. Wade had reached the good old age of seventy-five and we know from personal knowledge that up to very recently, at any rate, he had retained his brightness of faculty and that interest in the welfare of others that helps to keep one young.

A Good Boston : Without a doubt the number of good dogs going into the West is somewhat extraordinary. We seem to hear of them every day. One of the latest is the Boston Terrier dog Opie Dildock, C.K.C., 12812, which Mr. George A. Houston of Winnipeg, purchased from Dr. H. G. Kendall, of the Squantum Kennels. The dog is a brindle and white, a little over two years old, and is by Dictator III, out of Nellie. Dictator is of Cracksman blood. Mr. Houston intends showing him at Calgary and Winnipeg, with a possibility of sending him East to try conclusions at the Canadian National, Toronto.

Toys in the West : Ellon Kennels (Mr. Robert Charles) of Coronation, Alberta, report that their little King Charles Spaniel, Celamo Bethonn, is the proud mother of three doggy babies sired by the noseless Ruby, Celamo Redbeau, of Celamo Kennels, Rochester, N.Y.

Calgary Items : Mr. Dan Thody, now of Calgary, again sends us a number of doggy items referring to his new place of abode. First, he has purchased from Mr. P. Bawden of Ridgetown, Ont., a handsome brace of Airedales, dog and bitch, five months old. They are by Mr. Bawden's Ch. Caerphilly Marvel and are good enough to do some winning. They are jointly owned by Mr. Thody and Dr. Stedman, V.S. Another Airedale to go to Calgary is a bitch purchased from Mr. J. A. Laurin, Colne Kennels, Montreal, by Mr. W. S. Newton of Calgary. Since arriving she has whelped a nice litter of eight, six dogs, all healthy and strong. The sire of these pups is the famous Colne Rockley Oorang, the dam being Colne Mistress Royalist by Ch. Colne Freeman Terror, ex Ch. Colne Mistress Royal. This breeding takes her back to Ch. Master Briar on both sides and incidentally also to Ch. Clonmel Monarch.

By the way Mr. Stedman is desirous of building a large kennel for his Terriers and would appreciate any hints given, plans and other details. Perhaps some of our readers would oblige.

Mr. Thody, an old Bull Terrier man, has not lost his love for the white skins and is after a brace of good ones from round Ottawa way.

The Other Side : Now for the opposite side. The unpleasant one. Mr. E. W. Mermagen of Winnipeg, Man., regrets the death of his promising Irish Terrier, Terrence Mulvaney, C.K.C. 12481, who was run over by a delivery wagon, resulting in a broken back and of course death. Terrence, although under a year old had already placed 9 prize ribbons to his credit and was looked upon as quite one of the best of his breed in the West. This is one

of the unfortunate occurrences that take away some of the joy of ownership. However it is hinted to us that Mr. Mermagen is to replace the dog with one as good, if not better, which we hope to be able to report definitely later on.

The Right Tone: Dr. Murrough C. O'Brien of Winnipeg, in writing for recognition of his two newly made Champion Russian Wolfhounds, Ch. Genest of Roseau and Ch. Thelma of Roseau, says: "We anticipate the biggest dog show at the forthcoming Winnipeg Industrial Fair in July next, ever yet held in the West, and furthermore before another year goes by the Toronto show will have to take second place to the Winnipeg Shows." The above two dogs under the care of Ben Lewis competed at various shows in the United States recently and won for their owner first and second in six shows out of the seven where they were exhibited, Ch. Genest of Roseau having the honor of being placed "Best sporting" both at Boston and Pittsburgh. We agree with Dr. O'Brien that this is a good showing for two Manitoba raised ones.

Another Russian Wolfhound: Mrs. P. F. Mathias of Montreal, P. Que., has imported the Russian Wolfhound bitch Caerhysdu Ellka C.K.C. 12818. She is a white with brindle head and markings, and is by Ch. Ramsden Rajah out of Mauretania, being whelped on March 28th, 1909. She is winner of two firsts and championship at Taunton, 1911, res. open at Crufts, 1912, and other prizes. Ellka was mated to the English champion, Ramsden Rajah, before being shipped so Mrs. Mathias confidently hopes to have something good in puppies a little later on.

Winnipeg Law Case: Some time ago we reported in full the damage case Coltart vs. Winnipeg Industrial Exhibition. The case was taken on appeal and the following report gives in brief the finding in favor of the Exhibition Association.

The plaintiff was the owner of 22 Japanese Spaniels, which were exhibited at the Winnipeg exhibition in 1909, and which attracted a good deal of attention. She alleges that as a result of the neglect of the defendants the dogs became infected with distem-

per and 20 of the kennel died. The other two were rendered useless. In addition to the claim for \$2,525 damages for the loss of the dogs, the plaintiff claimed \$220 for veterinary services.

The defendants claimed that they exhibited the dogs subject to the ordinary rules and regulations, and that while they endeavored to take every possible precaution it was distinctly understood that the owners exhibited at their own risk.

Prendergast J., in delivering judgment, dealt with the evidence given as to the care exercised in the kennels at great length and held that the Exhibition Association had exercised the reasonable care which they were bound to use. The action, therefore, must be dismissed with costs. Plaintiff appealed.

J. J. Munson, K.C., and H. A. Bergman for the plaintiff; A. B. Hudson for the defendants.

Vancouver Spring Show: We have it on good authority that no Spring, or rather Summer show, is to be held in Vancouver for the reason that it was impossible to secure a sufficient number of fanciers willing to hold the show under A.K.C. rules. We simply state the fact as given us without comment.

Dr. Foote Dead: Toronto show goers will be sorry to hear of the death of Dr. H. T. Foote, some years back a constant visitor at Toronto show and a keen advocate of the Black and Tan Terrier, a breed in which Toronto was then made the show of the year. This was in the hey-day of the Black and Tan Terrier in Canada, and while the Black and Tan Terrier Club was about the most active specialty Club extant. Dr. Foote died at the early age of fifty-three, the cause being tuberculosis.

~~Canadian~~ Kennel Club Cups: The new Canadian Kennel Club championship cup is meeting with continued and unanimous favor and is certainly about the best trophy of this kind ever put out. Here are two letters received recently by the Secretary-Treasurer of the Canadian Kennel Club. Winnipeg Dog Show: A glance at the announcement in this issue will show that the dates for this live annual western fixture are July 16, 17, 18, 19. This show is held in connection with the Canadian Industrial Exhibition and since its inception has become more and more important. Last year a full carload of Toronto dogs were exhibited at Winnipeg and the show had its full quota from all parts West of Winnipeg as well as the dogs of local exhibitors. The show comes at a time when there is no other exhibition on and the holiday can be made an excellent one. Entries close on July 5th with the Secretary and Manager, Dr. A. W. Bell.

B. C. Cocker Notes: Mr. D. A. Tweedie, Terra Nova, B.C., has purchased from W. A. Twigg, Kingston, Ont., the black and white bitch Lady Midget, bred to Twigg's Red King. She has been renamed Wirral Blue Bird.

Wirral Blue Gown C.K.C. 12389 by Ch. Waverly Otho, has been bred to Mepals Omi, by Ch. Mepals Roue, the New York winner.

A Growing Kennel: Mr. P. Bawden, Ridgetown, Ont., advises us of the arrival from Wales of the Airedale bitch Swale Lady in whelp to a son of Midland Rollo. Details we hope to have later. With four brood bitches Mr. Bawden hopes to be able to supply the demand for Caerphilly Marvel stock. Airedales seem to be going stronger than ever.

Looking Forward: Mr. W. A. Twigg, Kingston, Ont., hopes to show a string of Cockers in Toronto in September. At the recent Winnipeg show, in the hands of Mr. Fred Miller and others, Twigg stock was very successful.

That Winnipeg Case: Under date of June 11th, Dr. Bell wires us, "Decision given in our favor on appeal dog case. Mailing full particulars." If received in time we hope to get details in this issue.

License Laws: The correspondence from Mr. H. B. Sims, Moose Jaw, Sask., Provincial Vice-President of the Canadian Kennel Club, is most interesting and shows what use the Canadian Kennel Club, can be made of by every dog owner.

In the Province of Ontario the enactment providing for the license of kennels of registered dogs has been resumed. The owner of a kennel of pure bred dogs if they are registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, on payment of ten dollars to the treasurer of the municipality, and when other formalities have been gone through, shall be exempt from assessment and any further tax in respect to such dogs for that year. The requirements are that every dog in the kennel be registered with the Canadian Kennel Club and that certificate to this effect from the Secretary-Treasurer be produced. The number of dogs in the kennel is not limited, the annual ten dollar fee being all that is required.

The License Department of the City of Toronto has so far refused to recognize this law, though, without prejudice, we do not see how they can evade it and the matter is being fought

through by local members of the Canadian Kennel Club, and also by members of the local kennel organizations. We understand that the City Solicitor's department has advised compliance with the enactment which for our reader's information is known as bill 82, 1912, "An act to impose a tax on dogs and for the protection of sheep." The Toronto License Department apparently did not know of the passing of this bill, hence a certain amount of confusion and cross-firing, which was both undesirable and unnecessary. It is understood of course that this bill applies to the Province of Ontario only, though most of the other provinces are now following along somewhat similar lines. It is not the pure bred, registered, well cared for dogs that the various municipalities are anxious to get rid of but the worthless, ownerless cur, a menace to himself, his kindred and to human beings.

Toronto Kennel Licenses: Mainly through the efforts of Mr. Frank Britton, Mr. Arthur Atkinson and Mr. Fred Jacobi the Board of Control of the City of Toronto has agreed to issue upon the payment of ten dollars, a receipt which will entitle the holder to keep a kennel of thoroughbred dogs without further charge. We have referred to this elsewhere and on a second reading of the bill it is not clear to us on what grounds such licenses, or tax, was ever disputed. We understand that no tags will be issued and of course the usual certificate from the Canadian Kennel Club must be produced. Following is a letter from the Board of Control acquainting Mr. Jacobi of the decision embodied above.

Dear Sir,—By direction of the Board of Control I beg to advise you that the Board are in receipt of a communication from the Chief Constable, in which he advises that the views of the City Solicitor have been obtained respecting kennel licenses and that the City Solicitor advises the Board of Police Commissioners that the City has not the power to issue kennel licenses, but that

the City Treasurer upon payment of \$10 can issue a receipt which will enable the holder to keep a kennel of thoroughbred dogs without further charge.

The Chief Constable adds that the Police, therefore, will not prosecute any one holding such a receipt.

Again to the West: Mr. C. M. Harrington, Moose Jaw, Sask., owner of the Robin Hood Kennels, has purchased from Col. Robt. McEwen of Byron, Ont., the imported Collie, Holyrood Bayard. We wrote very highly of this dog some months ago and it will be remembered that at the last New York show, in February, although suffering from a bad cold, he was placed second in a class of twenty-two. The dog has been re-named and registered with the kennel prefix and will in future be known as Robin Hood Bayard. He will head the kennel of this name in Moose Jaw. The other stud dog, Robin Hood Superior, will be sent to Maple Creek, Sask.

A Good Irishman Goes West: As we hinted elsewhere in this issue Mr. E. W. Mermagen has filled the place of his defunct Irish Terrier with a cracking good one. This is a wheaten red puppy whelped Dec. 23rd, 1911, and bred by Mr. Jos. Meehan of Montreal, who has favored the Irish Terrier for a good many years. This puppy is by Kilbarron Young Tip a son of Ch. Tipperary Tyke, ex Carnlough Juno. Tyke goes back to Ch. Mile End Muddler and Juno to Old Crowgill Michael and such famous members of Irish history as Ch. Mile End Muddler and Ch. Broda Muddler. The dam of Mr. Mermagen's puppy is Princess Badger, a daughter of the late Father O'Gorman's Ch. Celtic Badger. Princess Badger's dam is Ch. Princess Vigilantius by Ch. Bolton Woods Mixer, ex Mayreagh that goes back to Ch. Crowgill Paddy. This certainly is most classic breeding.

We saw the puppy when he was about two months old. He was then a sturdy little chap, all Terrier even at that age, exceptionally good in eye, ear and foreface and with plenty of substance. We advised Mr. and Mrs. Meehan—the latter the better fancier of the two—

to hold on to him and if he has developed as we expect and believe he has, he should give a good account of himself at the Western shows. The cheque that was sent to Montreal in exchange for the puppy was a most substantial one but Mr. Meehan assures us that if he had to do it over again the dog would stay at home.

BY-LAW NO. 231.

A By-law to restrain, regulate, and tax dogs in the City of Moose Jaw.

WHEREAS it is expedient to restrain and regulate dogs and tax the owners, possessors or harborers thereof, and to provide for impounding and killing dogs running at large in the City of Moose Jaw, therefore the Council of the City of Moose Jaw, in council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. There shall be a Dog Pound for the City of Moose Jaw and a Pound keeper shall be appointed therefor yearly, or till the successor in office is appointed.

2. No person or persons shall be allowed to own, possess or harbor a dog or bitch in the said City, without first having obtained from the Treasurer a license, and tag for such dog or bitch, and paying the following tax, that is to say, for every dog (male) Four Dollars; for every bitch (female) Eight Dollars.

Upon the payment of such tax to the City Treasurer said Treasurer shall give the owner, possessor or harborer of such a dog a tag and receipt for such payment. Such tag shall be regarded as a license and shall terminate on the thirty-first day of December in each and every year.

3. That such tag shall be attached to a collar to be worn on the neck of the dog for which it is granted, and no dog shall be allowed on any street or public place in said City of Moose Jaw without having said tag and collar on.

4. No person shall allow a vicious dog or bitch in heat, to run at large in the City of Moose Jaw.

5. It shall be the duty of any inhabitant of the said City of Moose Jaw and such inhabitant is hereby authorized and empowered to kill any rabid dog or bitch running at large in the City of Moose Jaw.

6. That any one of the City constables or any inhabitant of said City may impound in the dog pound of this City every vicious dog or bitch running at large or any or every dog not having a tag and collar aforesaid.

7. The pound keeper shall keep any such dog or bitch so impounded for seventy-two hours unless the owner or claimant of any such dog or bitch shall produce to him before the expiration of the seventy-two hours a receipt from the City Treasurer for the said tax and the tag as provided by this By-law and pay to the said Pound keeper the sum of One Dollar for the impounding of said dog or bitch and also the sum of ten cents for each day the said dog or bitch shall have remained in the said Pound for the feed of the said dog or bitch, and in the event of the said dog or bitch having been impounded for being vicious or running at large without a tag, or a bitch running at large in heat, but the tax imposed thereon having been paid, then unless the owners or claimant of said dog or bitch shall pay the said Pound Keeper before the expiration of the seventy-two hours the sum of One Dollar for pound fees and ten cents for each day the said dog or bitch shall have remained in the said pound for feed of the said dog or bitch, the Pound Keeper may at the expiration of the said seventy-two hours sell or destroy any such dog or bitch so impounded with him as aforesaid and shall bury the carcass thereof, and for such dog or bitch so destroyed by him he shall be paid the sum of fifty cents by the City Treasurer as full compensation for the impounding, feeding, killing and burying of the said dog or bitch on production of a certificate signed by a City Constable of such destruction and burial.

8. In cases where dogs unlawfully running at large cannot be captured any police constable may immediately kill such dogs.

9. Any person guilty of removing the collar or tag from a licensed dog

Canadian National Show: Mr. W. P. Fraser, Chairman, and Mr. F. W. Jacobi, Superintendent, give us the information that premium lists will be ready about the first week in July. An innovation will be made this year in the closing which will take place on Thursday night instead of Friday noon as formerly. Every dog will be kept in the building until the close of the show. The list of judges includes two names famous in English kennel circles, those of Mr. Sam. Crabtree, Failsworth, England, and Mr. Chris Houlker, Accrington, England. The complete list to date is as follows:—

Crabtree, Esq., Failsworth, England.—Mastiffs, St. Bernards, Bloodhounds, Newfoundlands, Great Danes, Russian Wolfhounds, Greyhounds, English Foxhounds, Doberman Pinschers, Collies, Old English Sheep Dogs, Dalmatians, English Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, Beagles, Dachshunde, Whippets, and miscellaneous classes.

Chris. Houlker, Esq., Accrington, England.—Airedale Terriers, Poodles, Fox Terriers, Irish Terriers, Scottish Terriers, White West Highland Terriers,

or bitch shall be guilty of a violation of this By-law.

10. Any person who shall register a bitch as a male dog shall be subject to the penalties of this By-law.

11. Any person in the City of Moose Jaw possessing or harboring a dog or bitch and neglecting or refusing to pay the license fee or to register the same under the provisions of this By-law shall be deemed guilty of an infraction thereof.

12. Any person in the City in possession of a dog or bitch or who shall harbor any dog or bitch to remain about his house or premises shall be deemed the owner of such dog or bitch for the purposes of this By-law.

13. Any person giving any information leading to the conviction of any other person for any breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall be entitled to one half the fine or fines which may be imposed and collected under any such conviction, the same shall be payable to any such person so entitled by the Justice convicting.

14. On complaint being made to the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction, of any dog or bitch within the City which shall by barking, biting, howling or chasing and barking at any horse or vehicle on any public street, or in any other manner disturbing the quiet of any person or persons whomsoever the said Mayor or Justice of the Peace on being satisfied of the truth of such complaint shall order the constable to give notice thereof to the person or persons keeping or permitting such dog or bitch to remain in his or her house or to remain on his or her premises, and in case such person or persons shall neglect to cause such dog or bitch to be destroyed or removed, or the nuisance abated so as to prevent a recurrence of such disturbance he or she shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this By-law.

15. The dog Pound Keeper of the City shall pay one half of the Pound fees paid to him for the release of any dog or bitch to the City Constable impounding such dog or bitch as soon as collected.

16. Any person or persons guilty of a violation of any of the provisions of this By-law shall be liable to the penalties imposed by By-law No. 221 of the City of Moose Jaw.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Moose Jaw enacts as follows:—

1. Paragraph 7 of the said By-law No. 231 of the City of Moose Jaw, is amended by striking out all the words after the word "thereof" in the 19th line of the said paragraph.

2. Paragraph 15 of the said By-law is struck out.

BY-LAW NO. 613.

A By-law of the City of Moose Jaw for the purpose of amending By-law No. 231 thereof, being a By-law to restrain, regulate and tax dogs in the City of Moose Jaw.

Section 2, of By-law No. 231 is amended by adding the following at the end thereof:—

Provided that the license fee for a pedigreed dog shall be as follows:— Male pedigreed dog \$2.00, female pedigreed dog \$4.00, and that the applicant for such license for a pedigreed dog shall produce with his application a pedigree of the dog endorsed by the Canadian Kennel Club.

2. Provided further that a license may be issued to any owner or keeper of a kennel containing four or more pedigree dogs on payment of a fee of \$15.00 on production by the applicant of the pedigree of each of such dogs endorsed by the Canadian Kennel Club.

FOX TERRIERS AT MINEOLA SHOW.

The Fox Terrier entries at the Mineola show were much larger and the class much better than in years. They were judged by Mr. W. J. Nichols of Wimbledon, England, and he surprised the fancy by the quick way he went through his classes. He did not play to the grand stand, but gave every Terrier a thorough going over, and he made many friends here. The Mineola show is a "horse trial" for the big New York show and if any one wins at Mineola his dog is good enough for New York.

As usual the wires were better than the smooths. The Sabine Kennels put down a very nice bitch puppy in Far Famed, who went through her classes until she got to the open where Baughfell Water Lily stopped her. Far Famed is a very short backed bitch, with an extra long head, but not good in eye. She has wonderful legs and feet, a grand coat and a shower for your life. Geo. Thomas had her in perfect condition. The Fox Terrier fancy were glad to see Mr. George J. Gould showing some nice smooths of his own breeding and it is hoped that he will continue. Mr. Rutherford is well known in Canada as he has never failed to show a team at Toronto, is reported as giving up the smooths, but it is hoped that the report is not true. Mr. Nichols was greatly disappointed in not seeing any of the Rutherford Terriers. Mr. Ingerswen, of Chicago, showed a number of smooths and in Niola El Rey and Niola All Gold he has two very nice Terriers. Baughfell Water Lilly is a very smart bitch. She holds her age well being over six years and was put down in good shape. She got winners over Far Famed which was right to-day.

In dog puppies Dr. Townsend showed one of his own breeding in Killington Drel, a very nice Terrier, winning puppy and novice classes. Sabine Rightful, second to Drel is nothing much, on the common side. Sabine Red Light is a nice little chap with good legs, feet, nice coat, and a good shower. Sabine Replica is a good Terrier with a short back, good legs, feet, head, nice front and a toppy shower. He went to winners, beating Niola El Rey who owns a short back, good legs and feet, but is shorter in head than Replica.

The wires were a much better class than the smooths. In puppy dogs Geo. Thomas showed a long headed, long backed and tall enough one, in Endcliffe Comedian, who owns a very good coat. If this pup ever lets down he will make a very good Terrier. Miss De Copet showed a nice pup in Windermere Cobbler by Corn Cob. He is a good coated one with a nice head, good legs and feet, but is beaten by Comedian in length of head and expression. Grove Bustles is a heavy marked dog, long in back, coat fair

and not so good in legs and feet as the 1st and 2nd puppies, no expression.

Vickery Quicksand, the limit winner, is a short backed dog, with a short face, has a good coat and nice legs. His feet are big enough. He showed nice for Mr. Thomas who knows how to get the good points out of a Terrier. Endcliffe Pivot is a good Terrier with good length of head, a grand front, legs and feet, but has never been shown in good coat which has set him back in many shows.

Open dogs brought out the best wires in America and Mr. Nichols was very careful in placing them. Lynnfield Salex who did so well under Mr. Redmond in Toronto last fall, was first. This little Terrier seems to improve every day, he has an extra long clean head with a grand front and it's doubtful if there is a Terrier living that has any better coat than he owns. Mr. Lynn had him fit to the minute and he showed for his life. Champion Wire Result is a short backed dog, not any too good in head, and his coat is a bit warey which will take a Terrier man to keep in condition. He has nice legs and feet, and is a good shower. Champion Member Sportsman is an all white dog, with the best of legs and feet, short backed, good coat, but has gone thick in head. Mr. Lynn ought to feel very proud to have bred Lynnfield Salex, who was able to beat such a lot of high class Terriers. The award was rightly received.

The wire bitches were also an improvement over the smooths. Vickery Spring Bud, the winner, is built on the same lines as Endcliffe Comedian. She is quite long in back, has a long head, a good coat, and tall enough on her legs. She should have changed places with Lynnfield Louise, owned by Daniel Riker of New York. This little bitch, who did so well under Mr. Lyndon at New York show, owns a nice short back, good length of head, good legs and feet, and a grand coat, but has a habit of throwing her ears back when she sees Delmont in the ring. Windermere Crafty is a good coated bitch with nice legs and feet, short head, and a poor shower. Grove Bloom is a heavily marked bitch with long back, good coat, but not extra in legs and feet. Vickery Spring Girl is a short backed bitch, fair length of head, good legs, feet and coat. Mr. Thomas showed her in grand shape. Radnor Rejoice is long enough in back, not any too good in coat, has fair legs and feet. Vickery Coquette is a bitch Geo. Thomas sold to the Vickerys. She is quite long in back, has nice legs and feet, fair length of head and coat, good expression, and a good shower. Mr. Thomas seems to have it on the fancy in putting his dogs down in shape.

Lynnfield Mary-Jane has an extra good front, good length of head, extra

good legs and feet but to-day was shown a bit short of coat. She came second to Bubbling Water and Mr. Thomas offered Mr. Lynn \$400 for her which was refused, as she is about the best American bred bitch out and is by Live Wire.

Bubbling Water is a grand bitch which Geo. Thomas imported from England and sold to the Vickery Kennels of Chicago for a big price. She is a short backed one, with a grand coat, best of legs and feet, good head and a dandy shower, a bitch hard to fault.

TERRIER NOTES.

Donald Monroe, who is known by all the Fox Terrier men in Canada, being Mr. Rutherford's Superintendent for over twenty years, has resigned his position with Mr. Rutherford and is reported to be going in with smooths for Miss Decker, a wealthy lady of Brooklyn. Best of luck Donald.

Geo. Quintard, who used to own Ch. Member Sportsman, Corn Cob, Saint Annes Primrose, and other high-class Terriers, is going back in the game again. He has commissioned a well known Terrier man in England to get him the best team he can in England. Mr. Quintard bought all of Mr. Thorndikes' Irish Terriers at the Mineola show and it is reported that Harry Hardecaste who has been kennelman for Geo. Thomas for years will be superintendent of Mr. Quintard's farm.

Mr. Fisher Ames of Boston is importing two wire bitches from England, in whelp.

The report that Mr. Daniel Lynn of Port Huron, Mich., had sold Lynnfield Mary Jane to Mr. H. B. Sims of Moose Jaw is not correct. It was Lynnfield Marjory, the little bitch that won the novice class in Toronto last fall, that Mr. Sims bought. She is a full sister to the Lynnfield Salex and is by Mr. Holgate's grand Terrier, Southboro Salex and ought to do Mr. Sim's a lot of good if he breeds her to the right dog.

Mr. Geo. G. Moore, of St. Clair, has bought a very nice Irish Terrier bitch from J. J. Holgate, of Doncaster, England. This is a grand fronted bitch with good legs and feet, with an extra good coat, and when fit will take some stopping. Mr. Moore owns the great Dromore Farm at St. Clair, Mich., where some of the fastest trotting horses in the world make their home and he will be a welcome member to the Irish Terrier fancy.

TERRIERS OUT WEST.

Fox Terriers still coming to the Coast, the last to arrive a beautiful wire bitch which Mrs. Thornton Sharp bought from the Duchess of Newcastle while visiting her home in England, where she spent the winter. Since arriving in Vancouver this bitch whelped five nice pups. She is a "Notts" bred one with a nice, long, lean head and a good wire coat. When in show shape no doubt she will be hard to beat.

Henry Cocksedge's good wire bitch, Brooklyn Jennie, whelped a litter of five to Champion Emroy Bristles which look very promising.

Mr. Cocksedge has imported another wire dog from England, St. Giles Slaw, who was a big winner in England. His last win was at Bristol, where he went through his class successfully under Redmond. Mr. Cocksedge has bought seven acres on the Frazer River at Whonnock, and has built some fine kennels. His Terriers will have freedom at all times at his new home.

Mr. W. D. Bruce's wire bitch, Maid of Orme, whelped a litter of five to his Marco Meddler of Orme. This is the next litter to a lone pup in the previous litter which was so successful at Victoria, so great things are expected of this lot as Maid of Orme is a wonderfully good brood bitch.

Mr. Bruce's Marco Meddler of Orme is in great nick, again this season walked through the wires. This dog has never been criticized in Canada, possibly because no one, as one judge said, could honestly fault him. He is a hound marked dog of beautiful size, with a good head and ear, his shoulders, body and hind quarters are absolutely the best. His coat is extraordinary dense, handles like nails and has a slight break in it. It is no wonder he was so successful on the bench while Mr. Bruce showed in England. Marco Meddler of Orme won last year at Victoria and Seattle nine firsts and thirteen specials, including best dog in show at Seattle over four hundred dogs in the show. This year at Victoria he won three firsts, two specials, cleaning up every special he could compete for. Marco Jr., his first shown, is a beautiful bodied pup with sound coat, wonderful bone, legs and feet, with that grand front of his sire, a nice sized head, rather strong but long, with a wonderful under jaw. He is rather overdone in ear but is clever with them. Has the ring manners of his sire, that is to say, he can move about, stand still when required to, and never gaps. He won first puppy at Victoria.

In talking over the death of Ch. Ingatestone Rustem, no one regrets the death of Rustem more than Mr. Bruce. He brought Camp Wee Woman from England especially to mate to Rustem. She missed the first mating, the second she had five, but lost three, leaving one

dog and one bitch and in these two he has the most promising pair at four months I have ever seen. Not only is this my opinion, but also in the opinion of that well known and old time fancier and judge, R. P. Forshaw, who says the dog pup is the best pup he ever saw. Camp Wee Woman of Orme, the dam of these puppies, was shown for the first time in this country, in form, this spring. She is a grand little bitch all over, a sweet head, all black in color and a body of rare quality. At Victoria she won the cup for best smooth in show, dog or bitch.

Several other importations into B.C. have arrived of late in the Terrier breeds.

Colin F. Jackson arrived back from England with two very fine Airedales, both dog pups. Mr. Jackson expects to repeat his success with his last importation, Ch. Matlock Bob. Mr. Jackson imported Bob when but a puppy and his success is too well known to repeat his winnings. We hope he will have two flyers. A pup he bred himself was very much admired in Seattle show and Seattle show was a great Airedale show, having fifty-four Airedales benched. Mr. Jackson's entry was 2nd in puppy. The first puppy went right through to winner's dogs.

Mr. Norman McConnell, of Vancouver, has a grand Airedale bitch in Ch. Killarney Queen. She has a great string of winnings starting last spring at Victoria, April, 1911, going through to winners; Calgary also through to winners; Vancouver Exhibition winners and special for best Airedale. Vancouver Spring Show, 1911, winners and special for best Terrier in show; Winnipeg winners and special for best Airedale in show; Victoria, 1912, winners; San Francisco, winners and special best Airedale in show; Portland, winners and special for best Airedale in show; Seattle, winners and special for best Airedale in show; Everett, winners and special for best Airedale in show; Tacoma, winners and special for best Airedale in show. Under judges Cole, Lyndon, Coats, Cransfield, Mortimer, Jarrett, Hess, and Thomas, surely a good record. Mr. McConnell has some young stock coming on which looks very promising.

Mr. Chas. Aetzel, owner of the Pacific Cocker Kennels, was lying at the point of death for several weeks, but has taken a new lease of life and is now on a fair way to recovery. Charlie's gameness is all that saved him, he put up a game fight and won out. Long may he live. Mr. Aetzel has imported from England a grand Bedlington Terrier bitch. If she is as game as her owner she will do.

Word comes from Winnipeg that that old time fancier, A. P. Muchmore, has a dozen or more promising pups com-

ing on. He certainly has a nice string of Fox Terriers and with the good ones and the blue blooded-bred ones, he surely ought to get some flyers among them. The game in Winnipeg among the Fox Terrier fanciers is very keen. Village and St. John have some good stock but have had luck in not being able to raise any pups. A. F. Picard has also some promising young stock.

Calgary also has some good Fox Terrier fanciers. H. P. D. Walker is the hard luck Fox Terrier fancier of the West. He is still in the game and fighting harder than ever. He has lost a lot of good ones. His puppy at the July, 1912, Exhibition, went through to winners and he refused one hundred and twenty-five dollars for it at the show and inside a month he was dead. This made three deaths inside a few months, but Harry is game and he says he is in the game to stay. Sandy McLean and W. H. Forrest are also breeding Fox Terriers and may spring a flyer on the public at any moment.

All down the Coast they are breeding better and more of them. Mr. W. B. Fechheimer, of Portland, Oregon, showed a pair of fine smooth Fox Terriers at Portland, the bitch going through to winners and she repeated at Seattle and with her litter brother won the brace prize for best brace in show all breeds competing. Mr. Fetchheimer is a keen fancier and an old timer at the game. For several years back he has been hard to beat. I have had to take my bums from him on several occasions, but I am still living in hopes of turning the tables on him, even if I have to send my best bitch to his Ch. Multnomah Blue and raise one by his own dog to do it.

Dr. W. H. B. Medd of Victoria has imported from England a wire dog by Sylvan Reflex ex Parita. The doctor has a nice string of wires and has had considerable success with them. Robert Large of Victoria has also a very good wire puppy and a nice wire bitch which has won several times for him. Irving C. Ackerman of San Francisco had two Fox Terriers up this way to the shows, his smooth dog Sabine Radium went to winners at Portland, Seattle, Everett, and Tacoma. Mr. Fetchheimer got winners bitches with his beautiful bitch at Portland and Seattle. In Multnomah Frantic Mr. Fetchheimer has a bitch that is hard to beat and at Seattle his dog Multnomah Recruit, many Fox Terrier fanciers thought should have won. Still his dog was just a little slack being at an age where he had not fully developed. Mr. Fetchheimer has bred all his prize winners for years, and is considered one of the best sports in the game. With so many fanciers breeding

Terriers the time is almost ripe for a Coast All Terrier Club. Boston Terriers are always a strong class at all the Coast shows and the Irish Terriers were forty-four strong at Seattle, forty-four were benched. There is a strong Irish Terrier Club out here, mostly fanciers in Seattle and Tacoma making up the Club. Dr. Hogan of Vancouver imported from Ireland an Irish Terrier bitch which whelped a nice litter and with it came a good White Highland Terrier that is a flyer.

This should be food enough for the Terrier fanciers for this time. There are several more Terriers I should mention but can not remember them all at present, so will mention them another time. Yours for good Terriers and more of them.

Mr. Hopton spoke very highly of these bitches. Taken as a whole the show was a good success.
