## The Canadian National Exhibition Dog Show

**F**OR as many years as the oldest dog fancier can remember about the Canadian National Dog Show has been a feature in Dominion dogdom, and the show this year was described as the Thirty-fourth International Dog Show, and possibly was the greatest doggie event ever staged in Canada. True, there may have been years when more dogs were bunched, but, therein ever was a year when more really high-class stock was on hand, nor has there ever been a year when more really interested people attended the fixture, all of which augurs well for the future of our friend the dog. When the Canadian National Exhibition Association came on their way clear to realize the long promised dog show building at King's, the first achievements of such a partner as a master builder for future possibilities, allowing comfortable margins for the growth of contests, the accommodation of exhibitors, the convenience of the general public in getting there will be an extension of patronage without question throughout America, excepting perhaps the great Westminster Kennel Club Show itself. The writer has always maintained that the present building is as good for the purpose of dog showing as most buildings so far built in Canada, but that is not the point, the fact is it is the first building apart from being absolutely the most harmonious with every other structure on the grounds, and any one so to the thousands who congregate at the Fair looking for the beautiful in every thing on the spacious grounds. Again—this tells in itself, but if ever a fire occurred in that building and got out of control, the result could only be equivalent to a catastrophe.

Those four members who were present at the General Meeting of the Canadian Kennel Club heard the President of the Canadian National Exhibition plain just what the situation actually amounts to at present, I would be encouraged by the optimistic manner of his reference to the possibility of a new dog show building in the very near future. Let us hope that Mr. Fleming's hopes will materialize in the very near future.

**E**ven hundred dogs were bunched with almost two thousand entries, the show was always crowded to capacity, despite the fact that the mercury was hitting the dizzy pinnacle in the barometer, proving beyond any question of doubt popularity of the dog show department, even on the fourth day when many of the best dogs had left the building. The crowd was immense. I had mission to the dog show was the same as to most other attractions, the show would literally besieged. A new dog show building with plenty of room, fair and light, and a floor the one floor gallerying necessarily of the

natural growth is department is not to be started.

The presence of Marshall support for several breeds, from American Kennels was quite pronounced. We noticed his Interna Nova Meutine Alsation Shepherd Dogs, J. W. Ben's Star Kennels, of North Adams, Mass., bunched eight of the choicest specimens, and being very materially of meekness of Alsatian Shepherd Dog exhibition one of the features of the show. The Star Kennels, and The Dunnottar Kennels (a Toronto Kennel) vied with each other in the decorator's art, and succeeded in making a splendid showing. Twenty-seven dogs in both breeds were bunched, showing that Canada has at last consented to take up the breed that is reputed to be the most popular in England and in America at the present time. Great Danes, Boston Terriers, Beagles, Whippets, Old English Sheep Dogs, Cocker Spaniels etc. were other breeds to have American support. The Bedlington Terrier was another feature, the only Major J. J. Gawthorpe, Horatio, known by the name of these terriers, being bunched, had gained thousands of keen admirers, each dog was a real Bedlington, and it was down in the shape, as may only be seen at the best English shows.

It is impossible to tell you every good thing that we noticed during our several visits to the show, but we can say that at the final, it was the happiest fix here we ever attended in this city. The Judges were, without exception, efficiently capable, and overcame the heats in good time with us here to themselves, and honor to the Canadian National.

Bulldogs, English, Boston, Collies, Wirehaired Fox Terriers, French, all these breed were in a rousing task in themselves, and it is to trouble the most expert judges on earth, so much credit due to Messrs. T. G. Hepton, Norman K. Swire, Joe Hill, E. Ward, and Fred H. Bearse. The exhibition management certainly made a happy choice of their judging material for their 1922 fixture. The building was again in charge of Mr. Peter Herd, and his staff of energetic men, who knew what they wanted a dog show, and did according to with the result that on the fourth day we found every thing sweet and clean. The superintendent admitted that he had experienced no trouble at all during the show. Squabbling, protesting, swearing, violation of the Eighteenth Amendment all being conspicuous by their absence.

Matters were to be counted by the hundred, and they came from the four corners of the continent, and everyone had an encouraging word to offer for the greatest exhibition in its kind in the world, particularly its dog show department. Charlie Stone, one of our oldest

landmarks, was a man constant in tender, meeting the old-timers of many many years ago.

The championship value of the show was five points making half a champion ship for these lucky dogs that found favor in the judges' eyes.

Well, here's hoping to meet you all here in Toronto again next year in our new and up-to-date dog building, the finest structure of its kind in the world.

## The Western Fair Dog Show

This fall fixture was again well organized and actually bencheted 12 dogs for the first part. Dr. J. In part-color dogs, Ottawa Fascinator, "went through his winners. He is too well known for further comment. The red-cocked eye with a wonderful long thick neck, and in the pink of condition.

My own bit's" Stanley Chamber, "Reserve was quite close hanging second. His dog is nicely coupled with full proper length of back, nice front and shoulders, and his head and muzzle reflect the right length. He was then flat-tail, the more in fact he would sure take some beating. This is the best young part-color I have come across in my observation for several years.

This bitch is coupled as she should be, well proportioned and strong, over the top, and in the front has shown her bathe in the right way. I might us mention this is also another good one by Mr. Lance Penwell's shot stud dog" Mando War. "And I predict this future bold individual will be equal—or may even eclipsed—by old famous sire" Billy Obo. "I have seen a number of this type, and in them the exception, they all show lots of class. Here's hope again it may live and last in my predictions.

R. J. Tyrwhitt's" Stanley Pegsey. "This is a real sound little bitch. Nicely from t., well balanced shoulders, short coupled, lacking a little in substance. No other year should bring her along. We will bear watching.
