Boston Terriers at the Canadian National Exhibition

As usual, nearly all classes were well filled, particularly the middle-weight division in dogs. It is a well-known fact that houses were of quality, better than most shown in the United States, and his show was no exception.

The judge, the Hon. R. A. Beane, of Springfield, Mass., is a man of high standing, both as a judge and a gentleman. His awards were well received, although there were those who disagreed with him in some instances.

Juvenile Dogs—1st, Dr. H. N. Thompson's "King of Ringmaster," a well-made, light weight, beautiful color, good tail, nice clean little dog, a fair over, blacked a little in finish. 2nd, M. M. Jackson's "Jackie Coogan." 3rd, J. W. M. Cousins's "Dinky Moore," but these puppies are promising, but too unfinished to comment upon.

Puppy Dogs—1st, John Schaefer's "Dr. Mack," a well finished, stylish young dog, showing a little time, a nice shot, square muzzle, flat skull, good color, markings and tail, but a little long in body. 2nd, "King of Ringmaster"; 3rd, M. M. Jackson's "Robert D." This pup also needs time to finish, and should be heard from later.

Canadian-Bred Dogs—1st, Mrs. Mary Evan's, "The Sultan," a sound, strong headed, middleweight, good color, a well balanced dog, a fair over. 2nd, B. B. Broley's "O'Pat King," a hamoot finished extreme terrier dog, good body, head, color, markings and tail, a little high stationed, but a high-class one, nevertheless. 3rd, Dr. H. N. Archambault's "First Up Kid," nice even dog, a fair over, with no glaring faults. Will always be heard from.

Novice Dogs (under 15 lbs.)—1st, "King of Ringmasters"; 2nd, "Clifton Buddy," a cocky little fellow, good color, very even over.

Limit Dogs—1st, R. A. W. Rastall's "S. D. Gus," one of our most consistent winners, a good sound little dog, good color, a fair over, good dog, a fair over, blacked a little in markings. 2nd, "King of Ringmasters"; 3rd, "Clifton Buddy."

Open Dogs (under 15 lbs.)—1st, Geo. Metilski's "Highway Bob." This dog is advertised as an international champion, and is a beautiful little dog in every department, and easily topped the show. 2nd, "S. D. Gus"; 3rd, "King of Ringmasters."

Novice Dogs (15 to 20 lbs.)—1st, "The Sultan"; 2nd, "O'Pat King"; 3rd, "The Prince," a nice dark color, a fair dog, a fair over, a well-carried, a well-carried expression, no doubt owing to the fine surroundings. Should do better later. 3rd, "W. W. Baker's"; 4th, "Bingo," a nice color and markings, in fact a good pup, but too young for the company.

Limit Dogs—1st, George Metilski's "Highway King," a fair good dog, nice color, markings and tail. Did not have much on the others. 2nd, Lewis and Brown's "Our King Pin," a strong headed dog, good color, blacked a little in hind quarters. Very clean in muzzle for a dog of his strength. 3rd, Wm. Logan's "Capricorn," a clean finished, well proportioned dog, a fair over, nice dark color, good tail and clean head, blacked a little in markings.

Open Dogs (15 to 20 lbs.)—A repeat. **Novice Dogs** (20 to 25 lbs.)—1st, John Schaefer's "Dr. Mack."

G. Long's & S. S. Hopkin's "Our Tess," a very much the same as the winner. 3rd, Mrs. E. Richard's "Little Dolly Raffles," a not so pronounced in type, and lacking a little in head markings, but a nice smooth little bitch.

Puppy Bitches—1st, C. E. Clay's "Baby Bell," a real promising youngster, nice size, well proportioned, good color, markings and tail, will always be there or thereabouts. 2nd, W. L. McGill's "Baby Ova," a most a ringer for the winner, but showing in help. 3rd, Glyn Bowden's "Bowden's White Sox," an extremely short headed bitch, nicely marked, good color, a little thick coat, but a nice one.

Canadian-bred Bitches—1st, "Craddock's" "Fleur de Lis," a splendid headed bitch, good over, but long in back, which stops her from being a real topper. 2nd, "Baby Bell"; 3rd, Wm. Anderson's "Anderson's Daisy," a also a splendid in head, good in body and feet, a peculiar hind action is her fault.

Novice Bitches (under 15 lbs.)—1st, "Baby Bell"; 2nd, Bowden's "White Sox"; 3rd, Mrs. W. C. Ingram's "Sweet Josephine," a nice cocky, a little bitch, blacked a little in strength and muzzle.

THE FURTHER ADVENTURES OF

BREEDING TO PRODUCE QUALITY

TORONTO WHIPPET BRINGS RACING HONORS TO CANADA

Colonel George Mitchell, the popular President of the Toronto Whippet Association, made a great hit at the Whippet Race Meet, held at Westbury, Long Island, on October 4th, on the occasion of the second annual meet of the Whippet Association of Long Island, where his game little "Skipper" made a world's record by covering the 200 yard distance in a time of 13.3 seconds, beating the favorite, "Gilligan's Tommy," going away. The meet was well attended, and was enthusiastically supported by a great throng of Whippet fans.

Mr. W. A. Gourd, the Secretary of the Toronto Whippet Association, lauded in his praise of the sportsman'ship that was so prominent in the meet. All of the courses was on hand with his famous "Resolute," but did not get beyond the second heat of the Long Island Plate—elimination race.

The first race was the Puppy Stakes, open to dogs and bitches under a year old. The winner was "Pucko Drum," owned by Mr. E. C. Kerr, Jr., which covered 100 yards in 6.3 seconds. "Humorous," owned by Mr. H. B. Phipps, was second, and "Josh," owned by Mr. B. B. Tuckerman, Jr., of Boston, finished third.

The Meadow Brook Plate, a 200-yard elimination race for novice dogs and bitches, brought out seventeen contenders. Those to qualify in the semi-finals were "Madford Domino," owned by Mr. C. H. West, Jr., of Westbury; "Millie Jasmine," owned by Mr. E. C. Kerr, Jr.; "Peggy," owned by Mr. George Chipchase; "Maxim," owned by Mr. E. D. Morgan, Jr.; "Millie Nidget," owned by Mr. E. C. Kerr, Jr.; "Dingle G.," owned by Mr. G. A. Wilson; "Audacious," owned by Mr. W. A. Gourd, and "Madford Manlio War," owned by Mr. G. C. West, Jr. The final was won by "Audacious," running from the 1-yard mark; "Manlio War," second, with the same handicap, and "Madford Domino," third.

The Long Island Plate, an open race for dogs and bitches, was won by "High Flyer," a newly imported dog, owned by Mr. Harvey S. Edgewood, with the nine-yard handicap, which covered the 200 yards in 12.15 seconds. "Spring," with the five-yard handicap, was second, and Mr. B. B. Tuckerman's "Champion Julep" finished third.

Mr. Peter Smith, Toronto, distinguished himself as a successful lipper, by lippering in eleven heats, and in nine winners, one second and one third. Mr. Gourd had the honor of slipping the hero of the meet, Colonel G. C. Mitchell's "Skipper." The Canadian dogs started in a free fight for the event, and won two of them, going away, and with speed in reserve.
