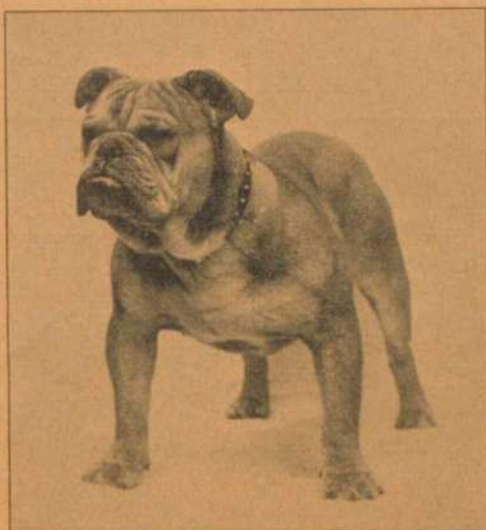

And it was moved, seconded and carried, "That the applicants be received as membership in the Club."

The Secretary reported that Mr. W. E. Baldwin (Montreal) had intimated his desire to resign as a member of the Canadian Kennel Club, and believing that Mr. Baldwin should be asked to reconsider his intention, the Secretary brought the matter to the Directors for their consideration. Mr. Wm. R. Aitken said that he believed that it was owing to extensive travels being made by Mr. Baldwin's time, he had brought about the wish to resign. The President and other Directors spoke very appreciatively of Mr. Baldwin's keen interest and past and favour for the Canadian Kennel Club, and on the suggestion of the President, which was endorsed by Mr. Aitken, the Secretary was instructed to again ask Mr. Baldwin to reconsider his resignation.

The President thanked the Directors for their extreme loyalty to the Association during the year, and his meeting marked the closing of, and expressed his deep sense of appreciation for the valuable service through which we have been trying to get, when long sessions had been the rule rather than the exception.

The question of the likelihood of the Canadian Kennel Club going in for Dog Shows was introduced by Mr. W. R. Aitken (Quebec) and after discussion it was felt that the time was not yet opportune for the Canadian Kennel Club to launch into the business of running dog shows in Canada.

The possibility and practicality of the Canadian Kennel Club holding General Meetings in Montreal and other centers during the period when the Dog Show were being held, was discussed and it was generally in favor, although no definite action was taken.

This being the business coming before the meeting, it was moved, "That the meeting adjourn."
