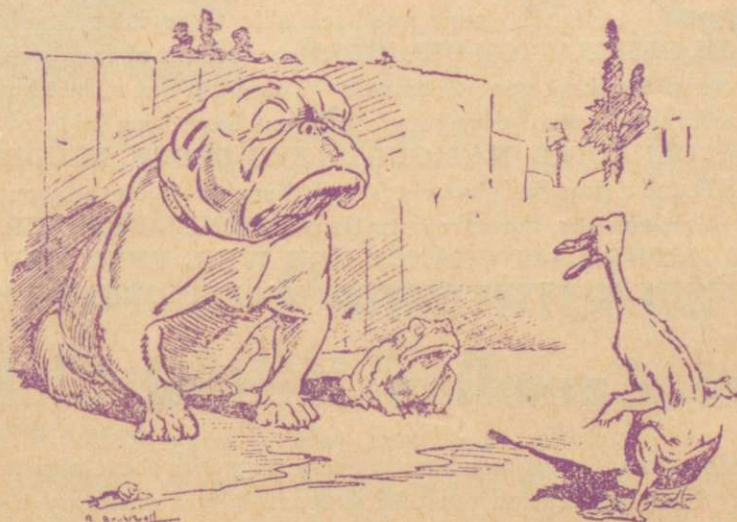

REGISTRATION !

THE Canadian Kennel Club has been fighting for two years to secure a ruling from the Canadian National Live Stock Record Board, which would do justice to members of the Canadian Kennel Club who have not been able to register dogs of **THREE GENERATION PEDIGREE** on account of the disavowance of the three generation rule. This fight has at last been successful, but certain necessary conditions have been laid down by the **CANADIAN NATIONAL LIVE STOCK RECORD BOARD**, and a time limit has necessarily been put upon the receipt of applications for these registrations. **REMEMBER THAT THIS IS THE LAST CHANCE YOU WILL EVER HAVE TO REGISTER THREE GENERATION PEDIGREE DOGS.**

The Canadian Kennel Club

is anxious to assist its members in every way with these registrations. Each application must be supported by a statutory declaration giving full details of the case. **AFTER AUGUST 1st, 1923, the Record Committee will carefully consider each application and the evidence submitted therewith and will decide whether registration may take place. Their decision will be final.**

In order to assist its members who are filing such applications, the Canadian Kennel Club has arranged to have the evidence put in proper form to go before the Record Committee. Here, then, is the proper procedure. The Applicant should write a notice to the Secretary of the Canadian Kennel Club fully outlining the circumstances which, in his opinion, justify the registration of the dog in question. If this information is given in sufficiently definite form, it will be passed on to the Honorary Solicitor of the Canadian Kennel Club, who will incorporate it in a statutory declaration in proper form without expense to the applicant. The statutory declaration will then be sent to the Applicant to be sworn to by him and after being sworn should be forwarded to the Secretary of the Canadian Kennel Club, who will forward it to the Record Committee later.

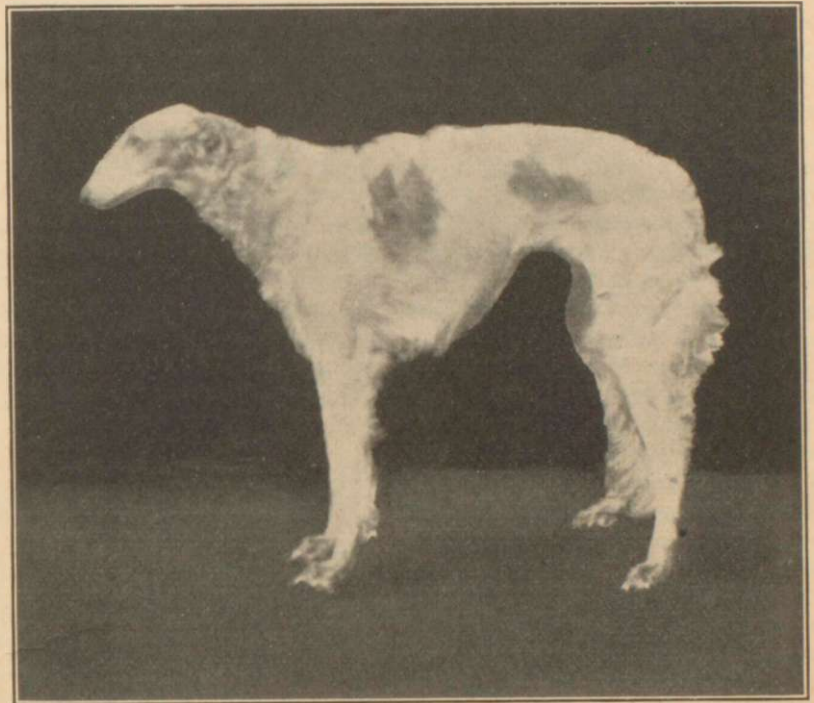
Toronto Comes to the Front Zahitra Kennels
