

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

HELD ON MONDAY, APRIL 21st, 1941

A meeting of the Board of Directors of The Canadian Kennel Club Inc., was held in the Board Room of the Club's offices, 25 Melinda Street, Toronto, on Monday, April 21st, 1941, at 2.30 P.M. The President, W. J. Risewick, presided. Officers and Directors present included: Walter H. Reeves, Mrs. E. Brown, Wm. McDerment, M.B.E., W. W. Rooney, and Capt. H. Dudley-Waters, M.C., J.P.

The Assistant Secretary reported that on instructions from the President, flowers had been sent to Director B. W. Essery, confined to his home with pneumonia, and that Mr. Essery had acknowledged with thanks receipt of the flowers and advised that he was now convalescing.

The Assistant Secretary read a letter received by Mr. Walter H. Reeves who represented the Club at the funeral services held for the late Charles T. Inglee, Executive Vice-President of the American Kennel Club, requesting that he convey to the Officers and members of the Club the appreciation of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Megargee for the Club's floral expression of sympathy.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES

In reviewing the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors held on February 27th and March 18th, Mr. McDerment suggested that in reporting the minutes of the former meeting it would have been wise to have specifically named the breed mentioned in the advertisements appearing in the Montreal newspapers, which Mr. Rooney had introduced for discussion. The Board agreed that it be recorded that the Walter W. Brown mentioned in the minute referred to was not the Walter Brown of 190 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

It was regularly moved by Mr. Reeves, seconded by Captain Waters and carried:

"That, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held on March 18th be adopted."

REGISTRATION OF BRADDICK'S TOBY

The Assistant Secretary reported that following instructions received, the application for registration of the Cocker Spaniel, "Braddick's Toby", under Section "J" of Article 17 had been forwarded along with Mrs. W. G. Powles' letter of March 18th, 1941, to Mr. A. P. MacVannel, Chief Registration Officer for the Department of Agriculture. Mr. MacVannel's reply of March 28th was read in which he pointed out that he was not in a position to override the terms and conditions laid down in the Constitution of The Canadian Kennel Club. After discussion it was agreed that the President would communicate direct with the Deputy Minister of Agriculture in an endeavour to accomplish registration of the dog in question.

REPRESENTATIVES IN ONTARIO

Replies received from Mr. George H. Hewson of Windsor, and Mr. C. J. Christenson of Huntsville, appointed to act as representatives of The Canadian Kennel Club in the Windsor and Huntsville districts respectively, accepting the appointment were read by the Assistant Secretary.

JUDGING BOOKS

The Assistant Secretary reported that the plates for the printing of the new judging books had not yet been received by Langley Harris & Company and that in the meantime the old style judging books were being supplied to show-giving clubs.

In respect to Mrs. W. G. Powles' complaint against Miss V. C. Rogers the following resolution was regularly moved by Mr. Rooney, seconded by Capt. Waters, and carried:

"That, Mrs. W. G. Powles be advised that her complaint against Miss V. C. Rogers is not sustained and that her first recourse, if any, is through the person from whom she purchased the dog."

COMMITTEE ON DOG SHOW RULES AND RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT

The Chairman of the Committee on the Dog Show Rules and Reciprocity Agreements reported that due to the continued serious illness of Director Essery, no meeting of the Committee had been held.

LETTER FROM MRS. H. E. BATT

The Assistant Secretary reported that former Director Dr. H. E. Batt was still ill and confined to his home. A letter from Mrs. Batt was read thanking the Board for the flowers and message wishing swift and complete recovery sent in the name of the Board of Directors.

LETTER FROM MR. A. P. MACVANNEL

The Assistant Secretary read letters dated April 8th and 19th from Mr. A. P. MacVannel in respect to the report filed with the Department of Agriculture following an Annual General Meeting and more particularly in respect to Section 2 of Article 17 of the Constitution. After discussion the Assistant Secretary was instructed to advise Mr. MacVannel that the Board of Directors agree that Section 2 should not be deleted in its entirety but the objection to the section would be removed providing the words "three generation" were deleted.

DOGS IN CANADA

The President tabled a letter addressed to the Board of Directors, dated April 15th, and delivered to him by Mr. F. W. Walkerdine. Mr. Walkerdine's communication dealt with the publication of "Dogs in Canada" from the viewpoints of economy and the Constitution and he contended that no amendment to the Constitution was regularly adopted unless carried by a two-thirds vote of the members thereat and voting. Examination of the minutes of the Annual General Meeting in 1939 indicated that the two-thirds requirement to adopt an amendment had been rescinded at that time. The Assistant Secretary advised of the number of subscriptions at present carried, the advertising contracts now held, their date of expiration, and the amounts involved also information concerning the printing of a smaller publication with and without a cover.

After a lengthy discussion it was agreed that the magazine would be published as outlined in the amendment to Article 2, Section 7, of the Constitution as adopted at the Annual General Meeting (1941).

After discussion it was agreed that the President would communicate with each Officer and Director and request their opinions and suggestions before the next meeting of the Board.

This meeting which commenced at 2.30 adjourned at 10.30 p.m. after recess from 5.30 to 7.00 for dinner.


