Honored: Mr. Walter Brown, President of The Canadian Kennel Club, by The Progressive KC of Canada. The plaque was presented in recognition of his outstanding service and faithfulness as a charter member of the club



and for his service as a board member and President of the CKC in two terms of service as well as his dedicated work among dog people . . . Dalmi, CD was recipient of honors recently when owner Walter C. Brennan, acting President of the Queen City Training and Tracking Associates, was presented with a Special Award Trophy prior to the commencement of the QCTA's second Novice Obedience Trial April 22. Mrs. Grace Probert made the presentation. "Obedience in Review" for 1967 by Mrs. Betty McHugh proved Dalmi to be the only Dalmatian in Canada entered in competition, finishing in grand style with the score of 199 at St. Catharines under Judge Ed O'Brien. An entry of 141 Shetland Sheepdogs, 117 in regular classes and the balance in sweepstakes, greeted her April 28 at the Interstate Shetland Sheepdog Club show, Feltonville, Pa. She judges Shetland Sheepdogs in Cleveland, Ohio this month . . . Mrs. Dorothea Deniell-Jenkins (Kennels of

the Rouge) West Hill, Ont. is now eligible to judge these terrier breeds in the States: Airedale, Australian, Lakeland, Norwich, Irish, Sealyhams, and also to judge the Group in the States. She judges Papillons and Bull-mastiffs as well, her chief breeds prior to majoring in Westies.

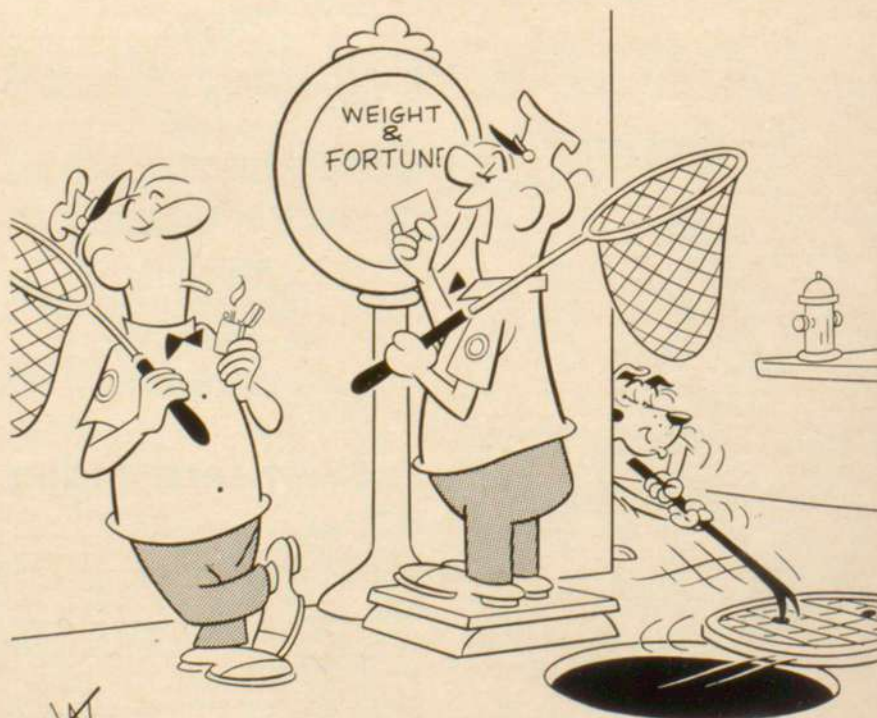
